



Middletown of which the above is a plat is laid out on the road leading from Zanesville to Lancaster and including part of sections 9 and 10, in Township 16 of Range 16 in the district of land offered for sale, at Chillicothe the streets and alleys are laid off at right angles. Main Street bearing North 50° East; the cross streets and alleys North 40° West. The streets are all 66 feet wide, the cross alleys 11 feet and the back alleys running parallel with Main Street is 16 1/2 feet wide. The lots are all 66 feet by front eight lots at each square 165 feet back; the four public lots at each square or cross street is 66 feet back and the lots lying directly back of the public lots with No. 10, 55 & 56 at the east square and lots No. 23, 24, 41 & 42 at the west square which are only 99 feet back. The lots are numbered beginning at the north east corner on the North side of Main Street with No. One thence westwardly to the western corner thence on the south side of Main Street from the southern corner of said eastwardly to the eastern corner and ending with Number 64. The lots No. 9, 10, 55 and 56 at the eastern square and lots No. 23, 24, 41 & 42 at the western square are appropriated for public uses and as such for that purpose hereby conveyed to the inhabitants of said town their heirs and assigns forever. In Witness whereof the said proprietors have hereunto set our hands and seals this 22^d day of February A.D. 1870 signed, sealed and delivered in presence of us.
