### Description

The town of Mt. Perry is situated in the N.W. 1/4 of Section 17, Township XVIII, Range XV, Perry Co. Ohio. The point marked "A" in the plat is the intersection of the Center line of Main St. with the Section Line on the West side of Section 17, above said at a point 21.90 chains south of the N.E. cor. of said Section. The course and width of the street as well as the names are given on this plat. The course and widths of the alleys are likewise shown. The positions, dimensions & courses of boundary lines of the lots are shown. The original plat consists of Lots 1 to 22 inclusive. Lots 23 to 37 inclusive constitute the Danison's Addition to this town.

### Dedication of Plat

Whereas, by these presents that the above Danison and Sons, James and his wife and John S. Naughty, John and Hannah Danison, his wife, and Joseph Schofield, and Mary Seefeld his wife the proprietors of the village of Mt. Perry, in Perry County Ohio, do hereby dedicate the streets and alleys as laid out in accompanying Plat to the public use, except the alleys between lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22
