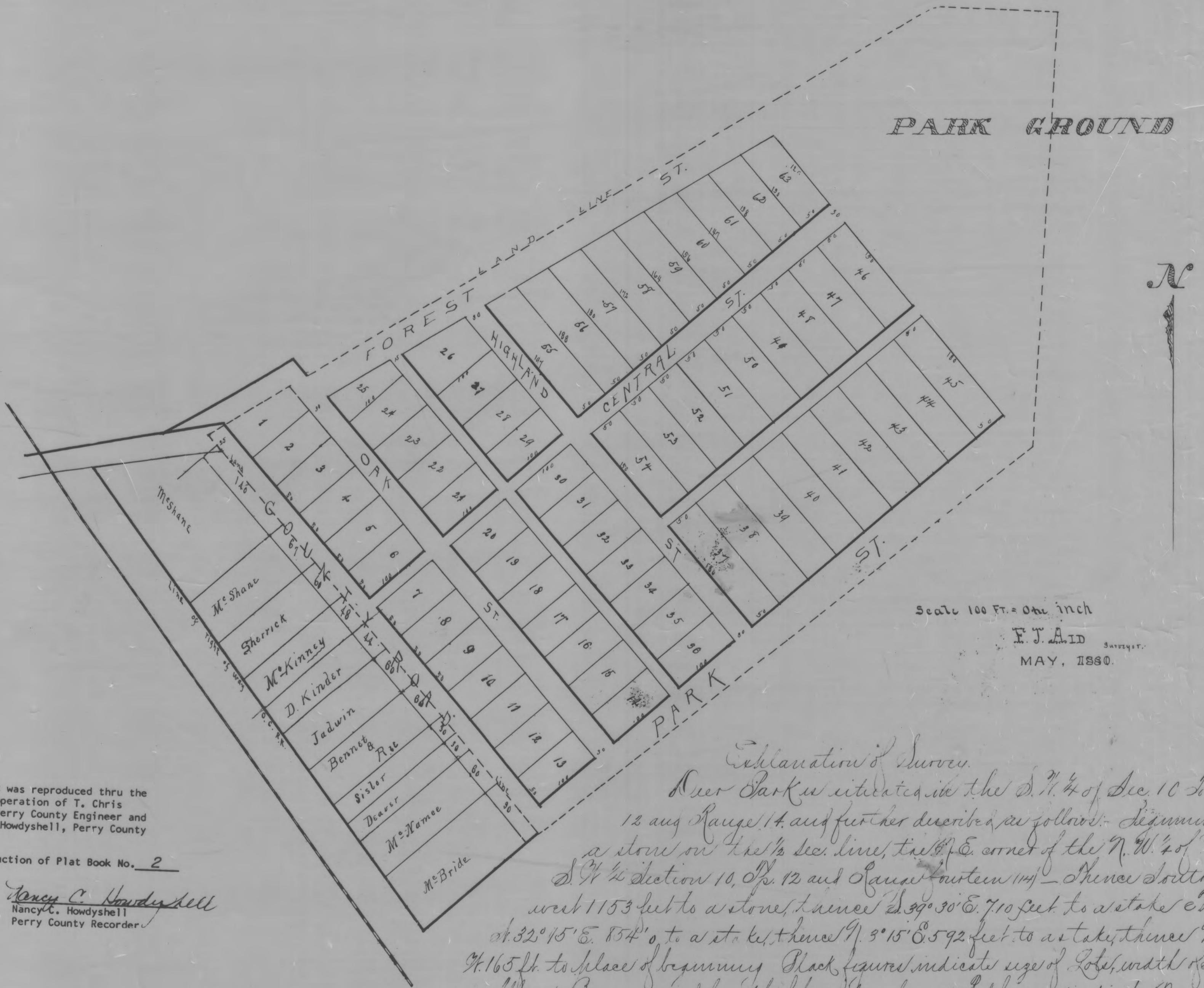


DEER PARK

Explanation of Survey.
Deer Park is situated in the S. 1/4 of Sec. 10 Township 12 and Range 14, and further described as follows: Beginning at a stone on the 1/2 sec. line, the N. E. corner of the N. W. 1/4 of the S. 1/4 section 10, T. 12 and R. 14 (Section 114) - thence South 60° west 1153 feet to a stone, thence S. 90° 30' E. 710 feet to a stake thence at 32° 15' E. 854' 0" to a stake thence N. 3° 15' E. 592 feet to a stake thence N. 86° 45' E. 165 ft. to place of beginning. Black figures indicate size of Lots, width of Streets and Alleys. Roman and length of boundary lines. Red figures indicate No. of Lots. I hereby certify the above to be correct.
