

Plat of Brown's Addition to the Village of Corning Ohio



Description of Plat
 Being a part of the West half of the South West quarter of section Fifty (50) Town Twelve (12) Range Fourteen (14) of Lands sold at Jansville Ohio - Beginning at the South East corner of said West half and running thence on the East line thereof North 22° 55' East Seven hundred and Twelve (712) feet to a stone at the South East corner of S. S. Johnson's Land thence along said Johnson's south line North 80° West Four hundred Seventy eight and 4/10 (458.6) feet to a stake on the East line of the O.C.R.R. Co. Right of Way thence South 11° 33' West one hundred Seven (107) feet thence by a curve South East to the South line of said West half thence on said South line South 87° 31' East Two hundred Seventy Six (276) feet to the place of Beginning containing Six and 1/2 (6.5) acres of land - The lots, streets and alleys and the dimensions indicated on the accompanying Plat -
