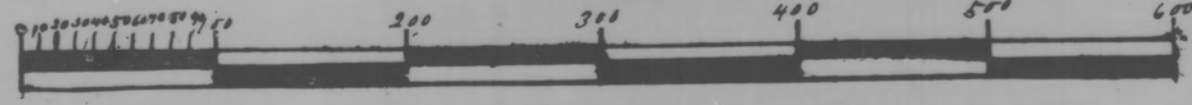

Explanation of Survey
 Carter's addition to Deerpark is situated in the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of section 10, Tp 12, and Range 14 the Survey begins at the S.W. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of section 10, thence South 86° 45' E. 619.5 feet to a stake thence N 38° 45' W. 211.2 ft to a stake thence N 71° 45' W. 239.3 ft to a stake thence S 69° 15' W. 211.5 ft to a stake on the section line thence with section line S 3° 15' W. 116 feet to the place of beginning containing 2.31 acres. Black figures indicate dimensions of lots and widths of the Red D. D. Numbers of lots and lengths of boundary lines.
