

Petition

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio

Your Petitioners the undersigned inhabitants of the following described territory, to-wit: A part of the East half of Section Nine (9) and part of the West half of Section Ten (10) of Township Number Twelve (12) of Range Number Fourteen (14) of Perry County, Ohio, Commencing at a stake 22 1/2 feet south of the southwest corner of the north-west quarter of Section Number Ten (10) being the North-west corner of Lot Number 8 (8) of W. A. Weaver's Addition to Rendville, Thence South 59 1/4 West twenty chains to a stake Thence South twenty five chains and fifty links to a post Thence South 50 1/2 East twenty three chains and thirty links to a post Thence North thirty four chains and thirty links to a post Thence West two chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing One Hundred and twenty nine (129) acres, a part of which has been laid off into Village lots, surveyed and platted by a competent surveyor, Certified thereon by him under oath to its correctness, and which is recorded as is provided by law with respect to deeds, respectfully represent that they are the inhabitants of the portion of the above described territory so laid off, surveyed, platted, certified and recorded. That your said Petitioners are electors residing within the limits of the territory above described - That the number of inhabitants residing in said territory above described is Twelve Hundred. That your Petitioners for themselves and on behalf of the said inhabitants of said territory have the same to be incorporated, under the laws of Ohio providing for municipal corporations, as a Village. That your Petitioners desire the same to be incorporated under and by the name of Rendville. And your Petitioners on behalf of themselves and said inhabitants duly designate and appoint as the agent for your Petitioners in securing said incorporation Philip Rie and Frank A. Turner residents and inhabitants of said territory. They authorize and empower them to do and perform all acts necessary to secure the incorporation of said territory in accordance with the laws regulating the incorporation of Villages. Your Petitioners further say that the map and plat hereto attached and marked "A" is intended by your Petitioners as the accompanying exhibit required by law representing the extent of said proposed incorporation, together with the territory laid off into lots and the parts thereof not so laid off. That said plat and map is made by a competent surveyor, properly certified by him, in which are particularly described, all the streets, alleys, commons and public grounds and all the lots, out lots and fractional lots within or adjacent to said proposed Village, the description thereof including the corners, boundaries and extent of the same. That all the in lots thereof at this time laid out and intended for sale are numbered by progressive numbers and their precise length and width are thereon represented and stated, and all out lots (none of which exceed ten acres in size) are in like manner surveyed and numbered and their precise length and width stated and represented thereon. That there are no streets, alleys or roads (which divide or border on the same) that at the corner of any of the lots, to-wit: Lot Number 8, and at the corner of each out lot a proper corner is established from which to make future surveys and the points where the same may be found are designated upon said map and plat all of which is truly represented upon said map and plat. And that each and every part thereof is accurate and correct and contains an accurate description of the territory embraced within the proposed Corporation.

Wherefore your petitioners by their agents above named pray that upon the presentation of this petition according to law your honorable board shall cause it to be filed in the office of the Auditor of said County according to law that the time and place for hearing said petition shall be fixed, and the said agents of your petitioners have due notice thereof and that upon the final hearing that your Honorable Board shall organize said Corporation as herein prayed for in the said name and grant all orders lawful and necessary in the premises.

Copy of Journal Entry March 6th 1882

In the matter of the Incorporation of Rendville

This day came Philip Rie and Frank A. Turner and presented a petition to this Board praying for the incorporation of Rendville, Perry County, Ohio, as a Village. It is therefore ordered that the same be immediately filed in the office of the County Auditor of said County which is accordingly done and the eighth day of May A.D. 1882 at one o'clock P. M. at the said Auditor's Office at the Court house in said County the same will be heard for hearing, and the said Philip Rie and Frank A. Turner are notified thereof.

In the matter of the Petition for the Incorporation of the Village of Rendville Perry County, O. May 8th 1882

Filed at the March Session 1882 of the Commissioners of the said County praying for the Incorporation of a Village styled Rendville, came on for hearing, being the time and place fixed for hearing by the Board of County Commissioners at the March Session 1882 and the Commissioners being fully satisfied from the exhibits and the evidence that the petitioners and their agents were duly and legally informed of the time and place of hearing said petition for more than sixty days after the filing of the same and that due and legal notice was given by agents of said petitioners for more than six consecutive weeks, in the Independent a newspaper printed and published in said County and of general circulation therein of the time and place appointed for the time and hearing of said petition that in pursuance to the Statute in such cases and on the 11th day of March A.D. 1882 said Agents caused to be posted a copy of the notice published in said Newspaper in a conspicuous place was in the limits of the proposed incorporation more than six weeks prior to the time fixed for the hearing and the Board of Commissioners after hearing the evidence, and after having heard and examined the said petition, find that it contains all the matters required that its statements are true and are satisfied that more than 30 qualified electors residing within the proposed incorporation limits and on the territory therein laid off into lots, platted and acknowledged as in respect to deeds, signed and subscribed said petition. And that said Frank A. Turner and Philip Rie were the duly and legally appointed agents of the said petitioners and that said limits have been accurately described, and that an accurate map or plat accompanied said petition and filed therewith that the name proposed for said proposed incorporated Village is appropriate and that the proposed limits of said Village are not unreasonably large or small. That there is the requisite population for the proposed incorporation to-wit: about twenty five hundred (2500) and that said Board of Commissioners moreover deem it right and proper in the judgment and discretion of said Board of County Commissioners that said petition should be granted. It is therefore ordered that said petition be granted, that the incorporated Village of Rendville as named and described in the petition be organized and that this order be entered upon the Journal.
