The part of Somerset of which the above is a plat is laid off upon the east half of section nine and the west half of section ten township 16 Range 16 of the United States land sold at Chillicothe. The streets and alleys cross each other at right angles. The direction of South street being south fifty degrees west and East Street and the alleys parallel thereto being with 40 degrees east. Lots Nos. 133, 134, 135, 142 + 143 front each 66 feet on South street and run parallel with East street 165 feet to South alley. Lots Nos. 136, 137, 138, 139, 140 + 141 front on East street 85 feet each, and run parallel with South street 132 feet. Lot No. 133 lies alongside and adjoins lot No. 107 on the former plat. The lots are numbered in the following manner, beginning at lot No. 133 and progressing regularly in numerical order along with alley to East Street thence down the same to South street and crossing East street up the same to South alley and thence along the same to the termination of the present draught which is lot No. 143. All the streets and alleys here laid down are given to the inhabitants of said town and the public for passages and roads and as such are hereby conveyed to them their heirs and assigns forever.
