

Petition for Incorporation of Junction City, Perry County, O.

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of the County of Perry and State of Ohio. The undersigned, petitioners, being more than thirty in number and electors of Jackson Township in said County and inside on and within the limits of the territory hereinafter described and sought to be organized into a municipality as hereinafter set out and described, respectfully represent that they have attached hereto, and made a part, an accurate plat and description of the territory sought to be made into and incorporated Village, marked "A" which territory is situate in the township of Jackson, County of Perry, State of Ohio, and described as follows, commencing at the South East corner of the North East quarter of Section ten Township 15, Range 16 of said Perry County, Ohio, thence West on half section line to the West line of said section, thence North on section line nine chains, thence N 40 1/2 W 53 1/2 chains, thence North 5 1/2 chains, thence N 76 1/2 East 3 1/2 to section line, thence North 7 1/2 chains, thence Southeast along the North boundary of N. S. & S. R. R. 24, 59 chains to the west end of Front Street, thence North 19, 10 1/2 chains to section line, thence West on section line 3 1/2 chains, thence North 20, 00 chains, thence East 3 1/2 chains, thence North 13, 00 chains, thence N 85 1/2 E 10, 5 1/2 chains, thence N 5 1/2 W 7, 25 chains thence East 5 1/2 chains, thence S 5 1/2 East 7, 1 1/2 chains, thence N 85 1/2 E 5 1/2 chains, thence S 5 1/2 E 14 1/2 chains, thence South 2, 1/2 chains, thence West 5 1/2 chains to half section line, thence South on half section line 10, 10 chains to section line, also South to long alley at the North West corner of Lot No 41 of Edin's Addition to Junction City, thence East along North alley, 26 1/2 feet, thence South to the place of beginning, containing Three Hundred and Seventy six acres of land, and embracing within its limits the Village of Junction City and Edin's Addition to the Village of Junction City, which have been laid off into Village Lots, plats, acknowledged and recorded in due form of law. Your petitioners further represent that they and each of them are electors residing within the proposed Corporation, that there are four hundred and twenty five inhabitants residing within said proposed Corporation, that said proposed Corporation is intended to be a Village, that said Village shall be known by the name of Junction City, that we hereby authorize John Edmiston to act for and on our behalf, and as agent for us in the premises. Your petitioners therefore pray that such proceedings may be had by your Honorable Board as are authorized and required by the Statutes in such case, to cause such territory and the inhabitants thereof to be organized into a municipal Corporation as herein before stated and prayed for.

Auditors Office Perry Co. O. Sept 4th 1882, The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session present James Boyle, Nathan Plank and Samuel Snider. In the matter of the Incorporation of Junction City, Perry Co. O. This day came John Edmiston and presented a petition to this Board praying for the Incorporation of Junction City, Perry County, Ohio, as a Village. It is therefore ordered that the same be immediately filed in the office of the County Auditor of said County which is accordingly done, and on Tuesday the 7th day of Nov. 1882 at one o'clock P. M. at the Auditors Office at the Court House in said County, the same will be for hearing. And the Board ordered the County Auditor to notify John Edmiston Agent for said Petitioners of the action of said Board. Attest Orrin Thacker Collector, Samuel Snider } Commissioners of Perry County. Auditors Office Perry County O. Nov 7th 1882. The Board of County Commissioners met in Special Session present James Boyle and Samuel Snider. In the matter of the Incorporation of Junction City, Perry Co. O. This day the matter of the proceedings to incorporate Junction City, Perry County Ohio into a village came on before the Commissioners and the Board being fully advised in the premises, full from the record that the petition contains all the matter required, that its statements are true, that the name proposed, to wit: Junction City is appropriate, that the limits of the proposed Corporation are accurately described and are not unreasonably large or small, that the names of sixty three persons who are electors residing on the territory are subscribed to said petition, that notice has been given as required by the Statute, that there is the requisite population for the proposed Corporation, and it moreover seems to the Commissioners right that the prayer of the petitioners be granted. It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Commissioners, that said Corporation may be organized, comprise the territory described in said petition into a Village under the name of the Village of Junction City Perry County Ohio. It is further ordered that a certified transcript of the proceedings and order herein signed, by a majority of the Commissioners together with the petition, map and all other papers on file relating to the matter be delivered to the Recorder of the County at the earliest time practicable.
