The description of the town of New Lexington are as follows, to wit: The town is laid out on the northwest quarter of section No. 9 in Township No. 15, of Range 9th of the lands directed to be sold by an act of Congress, at (Zanesville) The lots in said town contain one fourth of an acre, one hundred and twenty five links in front and two hundred links back. Main Street is one hundred links wide and runs 30 degrees south east. Jackson Street is 100 links wide, and runs 30 degrees north of east. The other Streets run parallel with Main and Jackson Streets and is 75 links wide the alleys also run parallel with said streets and is 25 links wide. The lots No. 25 and 40 are given for public use. The lots are numbered, beginning with lot No. one, in the southwest corner of said town thence easterly and westwardly alternately to sixty four.
