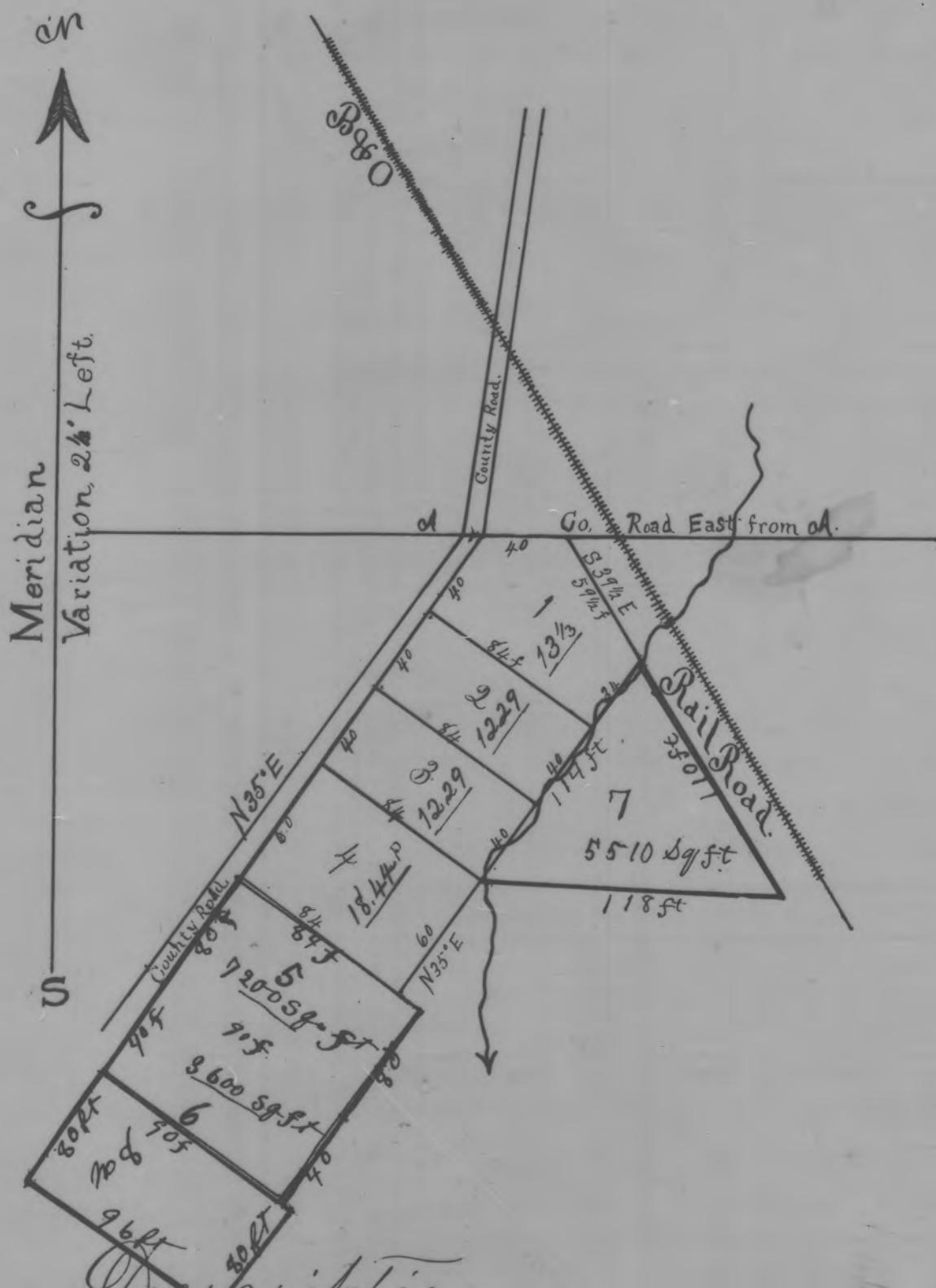


JOHN KING'S ADDITION TO GLENFORD PERRY CO.

Description

The above Addition is situated in the N.E. qr of Sec No 17, Township No 17, Range No 16, Perry County Ohio. It consists of 4 lots, numbered from 1 to 4 inclusive & progressively, beginning with No 1, which commences at a stone which marks the N.W. corner of John C. King's lands, said stone is in section line 18.20 chains East from the North West corner of said quarter section & 22.75 chains West from the North East corner of said quarter section. The Lot, all front on the County Road running S 35° W, which is the bearing of the front and rear line of all the lots. The side lines bear S 55° E excepting one line of lot No 1, which bears East & another bearing S 39 1/2° E as shown in the Plat. All Lots excepting No 4 have front of 40 feet & depth of 84 feet. Lot No 4 has front of 60 feet and depth of 84 feet. Lot No 1 is irregular its courses & distances are 1 1/2 East 40 feet - 2° S 39 1/2° E 40 feet - 3° S 35° W 34 ft - 4° N 55° W 84 feet - 5° N 35° E 40 feet to beginning. The county road on which all lots front is the only street and there are no alleys. At the N.W. corner of lot No 1 is the corner stone of said road, named as the point of commencement. At the S.W. corner of lot No 4 a corner stone was planted by my order and at the S.E. corner of said lot another stone was planted by my order the same being the monuments required by law to be provided for the purpose of future surveys. Magnetic Variation 2 1/2° Left. I hereby certify the foregoing to be a true and correct Plat & description of said Addition to the Village of Glenford, Perry County Ohio, as the same was laid out and surveyed by me on the 13th day of July, A.D. 1883. Second Addition to John C. King's Addition to Glenford, Perry County Ohio, consisting of 2 Lots No 5 & 6, No 5: 80 feet front & rear & extending back 90 feet & containing 7200 Square feet, No 6: 40 feet front & rear & extending back 90 feet. Front same as front line of all other lots, N 35° E, rear lines parallel to front & side lines at right angles with front. In the plat Lots 5 & 6 are shown bounded by red lines.
