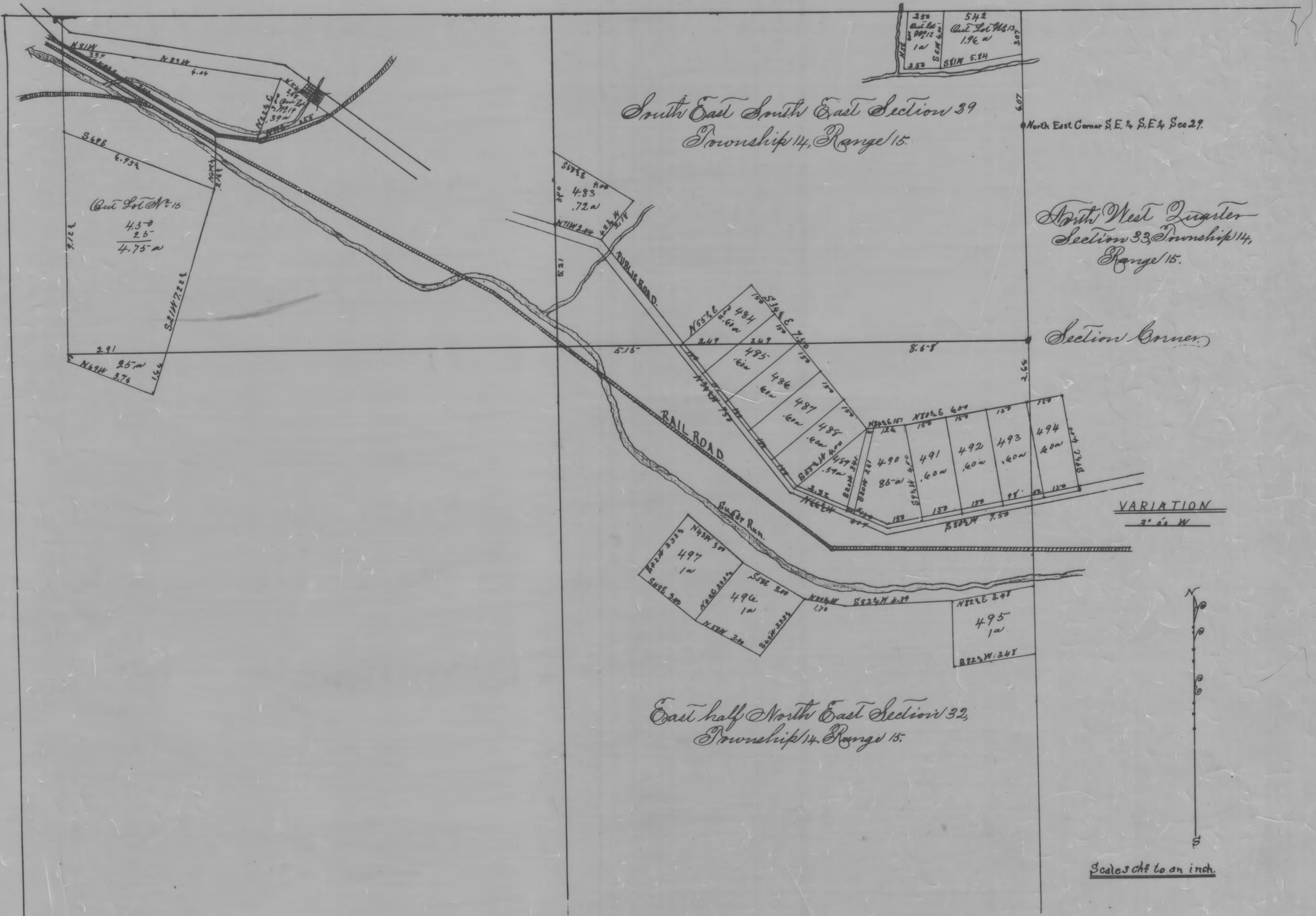


The Columbus Hocking Coal & Iron Company's Addition to New Straitsville, 2^d Addition.



I hereby certify the above to be a correct plat of the Columbus Hocking Coal and Iron Company's Addition to the Town of New Straitsville Perry County Ohio being a part of the East half of the North East quarter of Section No. 32 Township No. 14 Range No. 15 and part of the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section No. 29 Township No. 14 Range No. 15 and a part of the North West quarter of Section No. 33 Township No. 14 Range No. 15 all in Perry County Ohio Beginning 57.15 chs East of the North West corner of the East half of the North East quarter of Section No. 32 Township and Range aforesaid thence S 35 1/2 E 4.00 chs thence S 34 1/2 E 7.50 chs thence N 80 1/2 E 6.00 chs thence S 79 1/2 E 4.00 chs thence S 80 1/2 W 7.50 chs thence N 60 1/2 W 4.07 chs thence N 34 1/2 W 7.50 chs to beginning containing 67.2 acres. Also lots Nos 483-496 and 497 containing 3.72 acres. Said addition contains 15 lots numbering from 483 to 497 as designated by the foregoing plat of said addition to the town of New Straitsville the length breadth and quantity they contain are written on them respectively and all other distances width of streets and alleys are written in links on the plat and a stone planted at the South West corner of lot No 484 in said addition.
