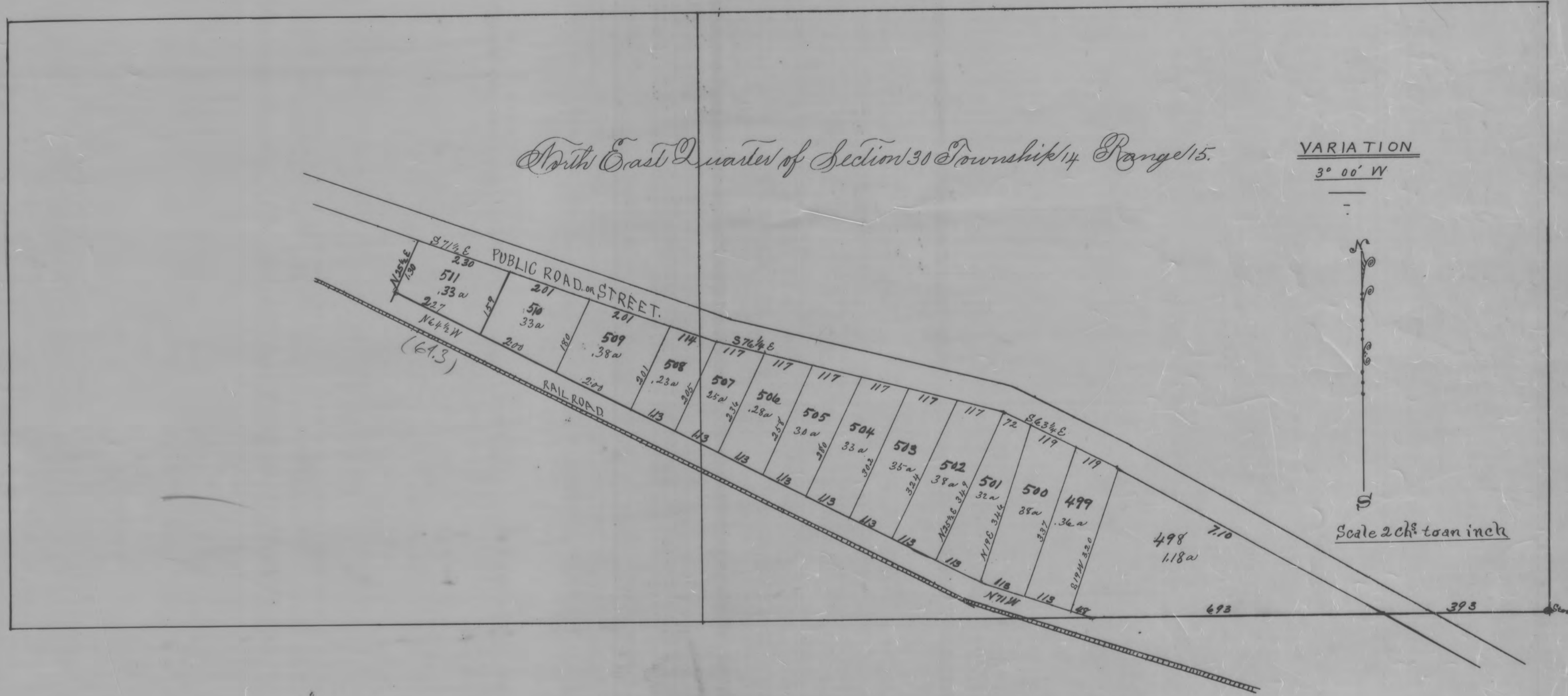

I hereby certify, the above to be a correct plat of the Columbus Hocking Coal and Iron Company's addition to New Straitsville Perry County, Ohio, being a part of the North East quarter of Section No. 30 Township N. 14 Range N. 15 Perry County, Ohio. Beginning 393 chs West of the South East Corner of the West half of the East half of the North East quarter of said Section No. 30, thence West 6.93 chs thence N 71° W 2.74 chs thence N 64° W 15.31 chs thence S 25° E 1.90 chs thence S 71° E 7.46 chs thence S 76° 46' 7.02 chs, thence S 63° 46' 10.20 chs thence South 60 chs to beginning, containing 6.88 acres. Said Addition contains 14 lots as designated by the plat, numbering from 498 to 511. Said lots are all fractional of which the length, breadth and quantity they contain are written on them respectively, and all distances are written in links on the plat, and a stone planted at the South West corner of Lot No. 511 in said addition.
