

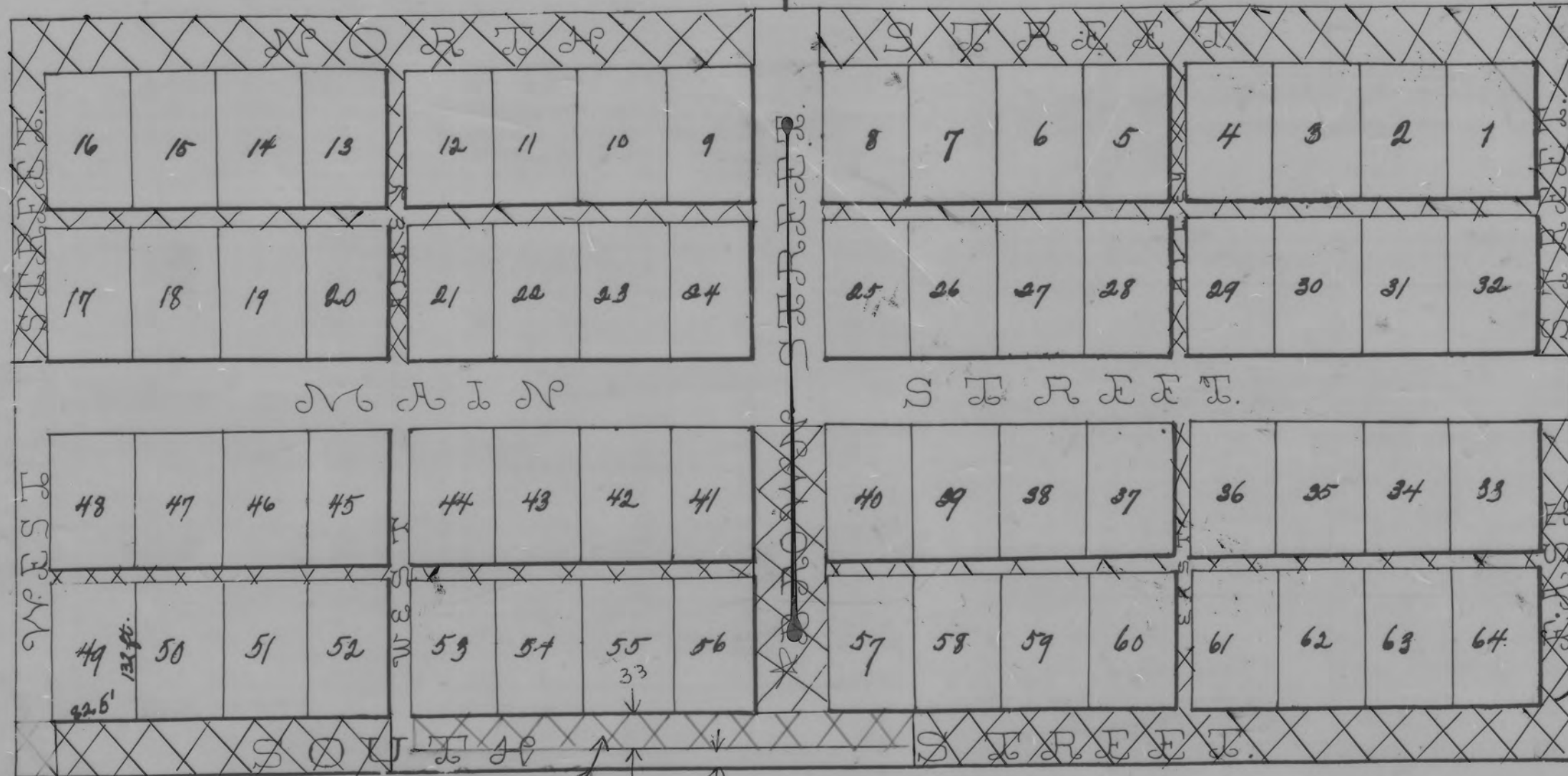


# BURLINGTON, BRISTOL

PINE Twp.,

Perry-County,

Ohio.

The description of the town of Burlington are as follows to wit: The said town is laid out on the east half of section 29 of Township No. 15, of Range No. 15, of the lands directed to be sold by an act of Congress at Zanesville the lots in said town contain one fourth of an acre each, one hundred and twenty five links in front and two hundred links back. Main street is one hundred links wide and run east and west. Brown street is one hundred links wide and run north and south. East and West streets are fifty links wide and run north and south. North and South streets are seventy five links wide and run east and west. The alley in said town runs parallel with Main and Brown street and is 25 links wide. The streets and alleys are given for Public. Also the two lots on the east side of the Public Square numbered twenty five and forty is given for public use. The lots in said town are numbered beginning with number one in the north east corner of said town, thence westwardly and eastwardly alternately to sixty four.
