



HORNPORT

THORN Twp.

Perry County, - Ohio.

Referring to the Map: The streets are right angles bearings at $S 40^{\circ} W.$ and $N 40^{\circ} E.$ Variation from the Magnetic points 1° to the right. The lots are numbered progressively bearing to the north east corner lot on the west side of Main Street at the S.E. corner of which is a stone planted 100' Nos. 18, 19, 20, 21 are 84 feet 9 tenths in front and 132 feet in depths Nos. 1 + 17 are fractional governed by alley No. 1 + 17. land line on the north side canal governed internally. Nos. 23, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37 are each 82 feet and 6 inches in front varying in depths proportionally as the lines of the canal, either converge, diverge therefrom. At the S.E. corner of lot No. 18 is a stone estimated at 250 lbs. as a governing point angular lines running therefrom at the bearings and variations before stated. Said stone is situated from the east boundary line of the S.E. quarter of section 4 in Thorn, in said Perry County due W distance 14 7/8 chains. Main Street 66 feet. West South street 60 feet and all the alleys 30 feet wide. The foregoing description concludes the lot part of said town laid out by William W. Balbott & the directors of the Licking Summit Reservoir Company. Narrow of lots on the east side of Main Street being added thereto by the said Wm. W. Balbott to wit Nos. 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 + 54 each 82 feet 6 in front + 132 feet deep excepting Nos. 39, 40, 41 + 42, which are 66 feet, 9 inches in front depth as aforesaid.
