Addition to the Town of Thornport. The angles agreeing with the original Plat Dist. Running parallel at $44^{\circ} E$ $2^{\circ} 40' N$ Variation from the magnetic point 1° to the right. Nos. 53, 54, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 100, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106 are each 82 feet + 6 inches in front, and 132 feet back. Nos. 73, 74, 75, 76 are 92 feet 3 inches in front and 132 feet back. Nos. 77, 78 are 81 feet in front and 132 feet back. Nos. 111, 112 are 76 feet in front and 132 feet back. A.P.C. - a road 40 feet wide, commencing at a post situated 2 chains + 87 links north from the S.W. corner of S.E. quarter of S.4 T.18 R.17. Hence $A 45^{\circ} E$ 6 chains + 31 links to a post, thence $S 56^{\circ} E$ 5 chains to a post, intersecting South street at right angles. Variation as above stated. Ballott Street is 50 feet in width and all the alleys are 30 feet in width. Fig. 1 is a ditch commencing in No. 105, as described on the map. C termination of South Street with the Newark road.
