BUGH'S Addition to NEW LEXINGTON,

This plat is located in the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section No. 9, in Range No. 5, and Township No. 15, of the land directed by act of Congress to be sold at Lancaster. The lots are each one hundred links wide at the east and west alleys and lie parallel to the east and west line dividing the section. There several contents in square links and square rods are placed in the margin opposite their special number, and their main length is one hundred links wide and bears as on the plat. The Steam Mill road is laid down at forty feet, hence the corner post in 10 is twenty feet north of the front lot, in the center of the Section.
