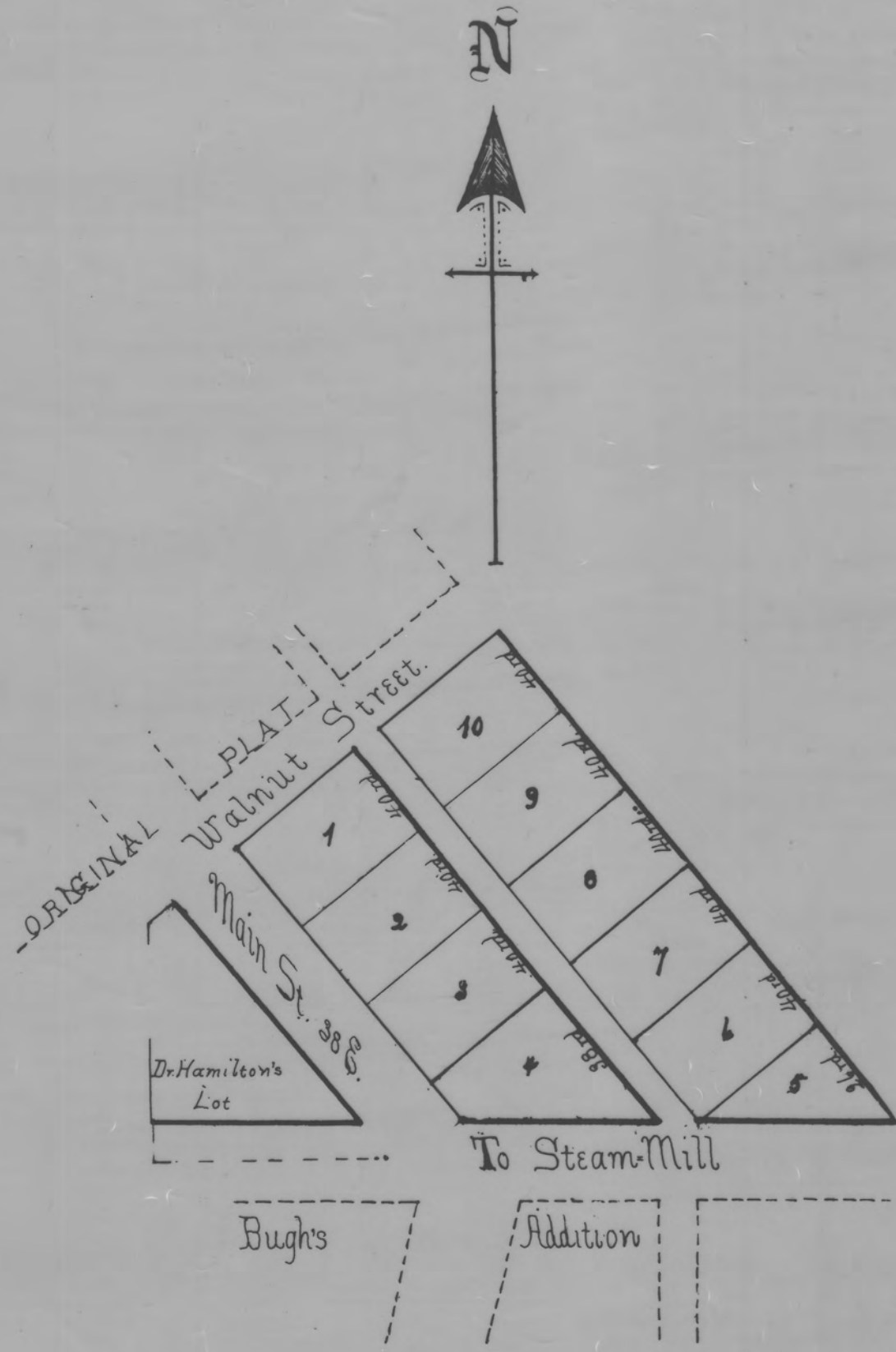


FATES' ADDITION TO NEW LEXINGTON,

BIKE Tp.
Perry County, - Ohio.



Fates Addition to New Lexington is located in the south west quarter of the north east quarter of Section number 9 of Range No. 15 & Township No. 15, of lands directed by act of Congress to be sold at Zanesville. Commencing at a stone marked N at the intersection of Main Street & Walnut on the south side of Walnut & East side of Main. Each lot is 125 links in front and 200 links deep, containing forty square rods excepting lot No. 4 which contains only thirty eight rods and No. 5 which contains 26 rods as may be seen on the Plat. I hereby certify the above to be a correct plat as taken this 9th of Sept. A.D. 1845.
