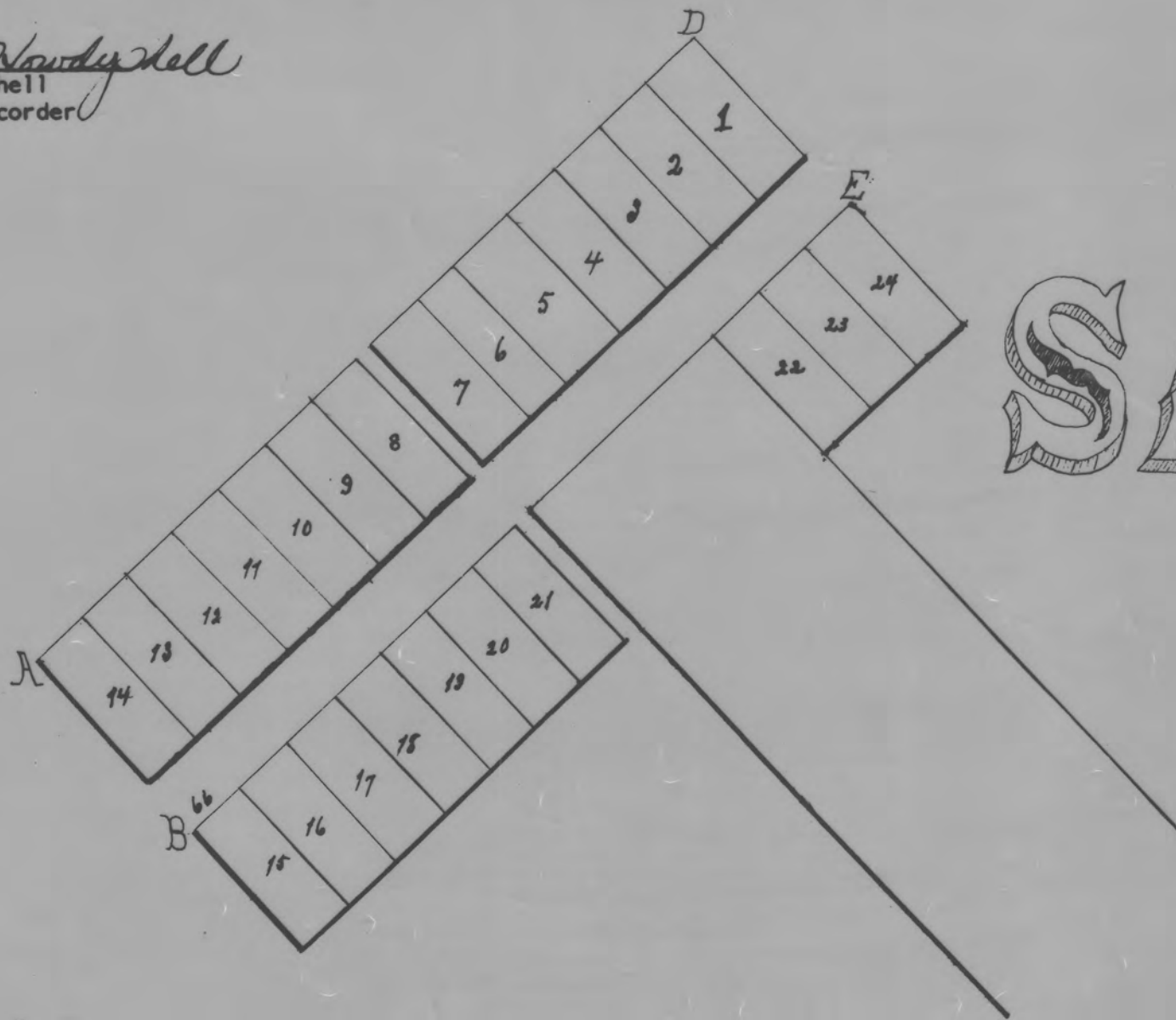

SALTILLO

Clayton Tp.,
PERRY COUNTY, - - OHIO.

At A, B, C, D & E are stones placed.
Variation 5' to the right.
Scale - 10 rods to an inch.

The town lots of Saltillo are laid out 4 rods wide and ten rods long. Except lot No. 7 which is four rods six feet wide, No. 6 is 44 feet wide. Lot No. 5 is four rods and 15 links wide. Lots No. 22, 23 & 24 are each 3 rods and 15 links wide. Main Street runs N. 46° E. and the alleys running parallel with the lots run S. 44° W. Main Street is 4 rods wide. The alleys are 12 feet wide as surveyed by me April 1848. J. Brown C.S.

The State of Ohio, Perry County, ss. I do hereby certify the foregoing to be correct as professionally done up and filed out by me. James Brown, C.S.

The State of Ohio, Perry County, ss. Personally appeared before me the subscriber, an acting Justice of the Peace in and for said County, Robert Bradshaw and Mary his wife, William Adams and Amelia his wife, Andrew Kurl and Lavina his wife, Grantors of the foregoing town plat of Saltillo and acknowledged the same to be their voluntary act and deed for the special purposes therein contained. Also afterwards appeared as aforesaid the said Mary wife of the said Robert Bradshaw, and Amelia wife of said Wm Adams and Lavina wife of said Andrew Kurl, all of them examined separately and apart from their said husbands, and the contents of this instrument being fully explained to her by me in the absence and out of the hearing of their said husbands, they did on said examination acknowledge the same to be their several own free act and deed for the special purposes therein contained and that they are still satisfied therewith.
