Personally appeared before me a Justice of the Peace for said County John J. Westerman and Clarissa Westerman his wife who acknowledged the foregoing town plat to be their voluntary act and deed for the special purposes therein contained. The said Clarissa Westerman wife of the said John J. Westerman being by me examined <sup>separately</sup> separate and apart from her said husband, acknowledged that she signed and sealed the same to be her own free will and accord and that she fully relinquishes her dower therein and that she does the same without the threats or coercion of her said husband.
