The lots in Portersville are of various dimensions by reference to the plat will more fully appear. Main Street runs N. 75° W. and is fifty seven feet 9 inches wide. Mechanics Street runs due North and is 57 feet nine inches wide. The alleys are 12 feet wide. All the division lines of lots bear and run N. 15° E. and form a right angle with Main Street. Portersville was laid out by John Porter Genl. proprietor on the east half of section No. 24 in Township No. 18 Range No. 14 Perry County Ohio. Survey of November the 10th 1848 Ad. 1848, by James Brown & Co. State of Ohio, Perry County, I do hereby certify that the above survey as made down is an accurate survey. Given under my hand this 14th day of November 1848. James Brown & Co.

Personally appeared before me the subscriber, an acting Justice of the Peace in and for said County John Porter and Elizabeth his wife, signers of the foregoing town plat and severally acknowledged the signing and sealing thereof to be their act and deed for the special purpose therein contained. Her afterwards the said Elizabeth wife of the said John Porter being examined by me, separate and apart from her said husband and the contents of this deed being fully made known to her by me, she acknowledged that she executed the same, freely without fear, threats or coercion of her said husband and that she is still satisfied therewith.
