COMLY'S ADDITION TO New Lexington,

Pike Township,

PERRY COUNTY, --- OHIO.

The townlots of David Comly's addition to New Lexington are laid out corresponding to the original Town Plat of New Lexington viz. - N. 51° E. by N. 31° W. and the contrary, the lots contain 1/4 of an acre each, except lots No. 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 100, 101, 102 & 103 which will more fully appear on the plat. The alleys are each 1 rod wide. Surveyed September 11th and 12th 1849.
