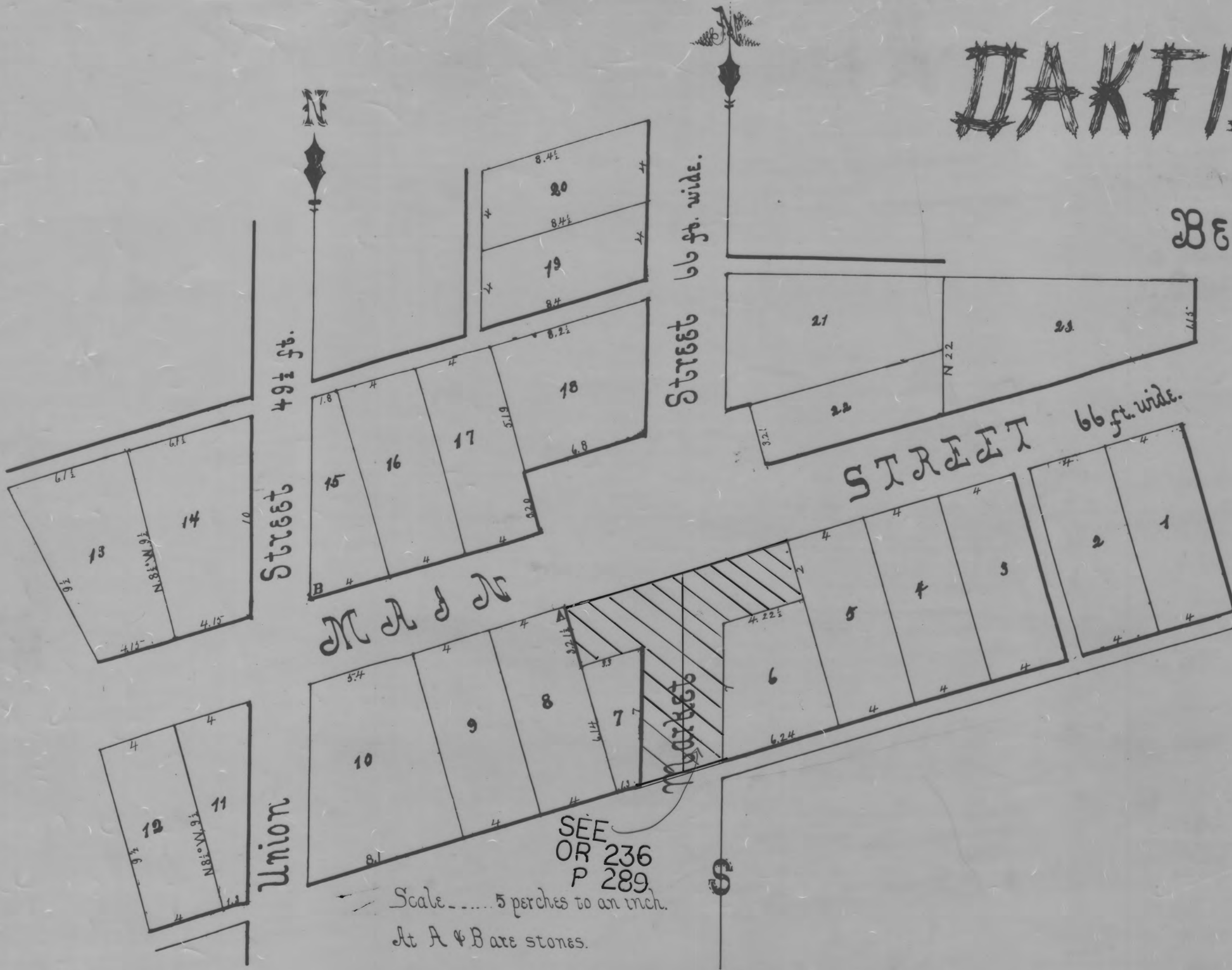


DAKFIELD

In the town of Dakfield, situated in Perry County Ohio, Main Street runs $et. 75^{\circ} E$ and South Valley parallel. Market Street runs due north, and the alley west of lots No. 19 & 20, runs due north. Union Street runs due north and is 49 1/2 feet wide. The other two streets is 66 feet wide and all the alleys are twelve feet wide. Lots No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, runs north 17° degrees West, the other lines adjoining said lots will appear on the plat and run with Market Street. All the other lines run parallel with Main Street except the north line of lot 21, which runs East.
