Lots Nos. 9 & 10 commence N 86° W 2 Rd. & 21 links from the N.W. corner of lot No 2.  
At A, B, C & D corner stones are planted.

Maxville is situated in Monday Creek Township, Perry County, Ohio, on Sections No. 16 & 17 on the graded state road leading from Logan Main Street laid off from the N.W. corner of lot No 7, S 85 1/2° W. to the S.E. corner of lot No 5, and is 2 rods and 11 links wide and also from the N.W. corner of lot No 2 to the S.E. corner of lot No 9 bears S 86 1/2° W. and is 2 rods and 21 links wide. No other dimensions of said street taken except the bearings which is S 30° W from the beginning point at the most northerly corner of lot No 1 to the N.W. corner of lot No 3, thence S 20° West to the N.W. corner of lot No 7. The lots are various areas. Market street runs South W.C. from Main Street and is 35 1/2 links wide. For other references see plat surveyed May the 16<sup>th</sup> 1850 for Wm.
