The minutes of Comly's new Addition to New Lexington are as follows: Main Street is 4 rods wide and Jackson Street is 8 rods wide and run N. 38° W. and the alleys parallel thereto are one rod wide. Water Street runs N. 57° E. to the N. E. corner of lot No. 115 and is 8 rods wide; for continuation see plat. Lumber Street runs N. 57° E. and is 8 rods wide and the alleys parallel thereto are one rod wide. Lot No. 115, 116, 117, 118 are each 4 rods in front and 7 rods long, to the alley and each contain 28 rods of land. Lots No. 119, 120, 121, 122, 123 & 124 are each 8 rods in front and 5 rods long to the alley and each contain 24 rods of land and Lot No. 125 contains 159 7/8 Perches Surveyed June the 5th 1854.
