Plat of College Addition to the Town of Somerset in Perry County and State of Ohio. The said addition being in the west half of section No. 10, Township No. 16, situated in the County and State aforesaid. The lots are laid off on Main and Harrison Street in the said town of Somerset, North Street on the north side of the said addition, is 47 feet wide. Harrison Street is 60 feet wide. The alley between lots 2, 3, & 4 is 20 feet wide. The alley on the east side of the said addition is 20 feet wide. The following is a description of the meter and bounds of the lots contained in the said College Addition as they are numbered on the above Plat.

Lot No. 1. Beginning at the point of intersection between the east side of Harrison Street and the north side of Main Street, thence as follows: 1. S. 54° E. 9 perches 19 1/2 links. - 2. - S. 40° W. 9 perches 19 1/2 links. - 3. - S. 54° W. 9 perches 19 1/2 links. - 4. - S. 40° E. 9 perches 19 1/2 links. Area 95.6 Square perches. Lot No. 2. Beginning at the S.E. corner of Lot No. 1 thence as follows: 1. - S. 54° E. 3 perches 2 1/2 links, 2. - S. 40° W. 9 perches 19 1/2 links. 3. - S. 54° W. 3 perches 2 1/2 links. 4. - S. 40° E. 9 perches 19 1/2 links. Area 97.7 Square perches. Lot No. 3. Beginning at the South east corner of Lot No. 2, thence as follows: 1. - S. 54° E. 3 perches 2 1/2 links. 2. - S. 40° W. 9 perches 19 1/2 links. 3. - S. 54° W. 3 perches 2 1/2 links. 4. - S. 40° E. 9 1/2 links. Area 37.7 Square perches. Lot No. 4. Beginning at the point of intersection between the north line of the 20 feet - and the east side of Harrison Street thence as follows: 1. S. 54° E. 17 perches 12 links. 2. - S. 40° W. 3 perches 15 1/2 links. 3. - S. 54° W. 7 perches 12 1/2 links. 4. - S. 40° E. 3 perches 15 1/2 links. Area 63.5 sq. perches. Lot No. 5. Beginning at the point of intersection between the East side of Harrison Street and the South side of North Street thence as follows: 1. S. 54° E. 47 perches 12 1/2 links. 2. - S. 40° E. 5 perches 20 3/4 links. 3. - S. 54° W. 17 perches 12 1/2 links. 4. - N. 40° W. 5 perches 20 3/4 links. Area 101.6 square perches. At the S.W. corner of Lot No. 1 there is planted a good and sufficient stone, according to law.
