



The S.E. corner of lot No. 10, bears from the S.W. corner of lot No. 1, $S 87^{\circ} W 4 P. 07 L.$
 There is to be an alley from the street through the middle of lot No. 9, of 10 feet in width.



ADDITION TO MAXVILLE.

In lot No. 9 an allowance of 10 feet is made for the alley.

The said addition being in Section No. 16, Township No. 14, of Range No. 16, situate in the County of Perry and State of Ohio, on the Graded State road leading to Logan. A line stone weighing 24 pounds is planted at the southwest corner of lot No. 1. The alley between lot No. 1 and the adjacent lot south is 20 feet wide; between 1 and 2 the alley is 19 feet wide; between lots 3 & 4 the alley is 10 feet wide.
