The outlines, marked with red ink represent the extent of the territory proposed to be annexed. All the numbered lots within said limits upto and including number 135 are now within the corporate limits of New Lexington. R. E. Huston's 2nd Addition has been surveyed and platted but not recorded at this date May 5th 1856.

To the Commissioners of Perry Co. Ohio, Greeting
Your petitioners, would represent to your honorable body that the municipal election held in the Incorporated Village of New Lexington 17th day of April 1856 the reverend ninety one legal voters resident of said incorporated village voted in favor of annexing certain contiguous territory to said incorporated village. (A more full description given of said territory on plat marked A) and hereunto attached were at said municipal election five legal voters residents of said incorporated village voted against said annexation. The question of Annexation having been submitted to the qualified electors of said incorporated village by an ordinance passed for the purpose by the Council on the 22nd day of February 1856 reference being had to a copy of said act hereunto attached marked A. Your Petitioners would therefore ask your honorable body to annex to the incorporated village of New Lexington all the territory within the following described boundary that is not already in said incorporation namely:— Commencing at the northwest corner of lot No. 130 in R. E. Huston's 1st Addition to New Lexington thence in a north westerly direction nearly parallel with to a point on the south east side of Brook Street opposite the north east corner of lot 156 in R. E. Huston's 2nd Addition thence along the south east side of Brook Street to a point opposite the north east corner of lot No. 149 in said 2nd Addition, thence in a easterly direction parallel with the north east line of said lot no. 149 to Highwater mark on the north side of Rush Creek thence along the north side of said Creek to a point where the road leading from New Lexington to Somerset crosses said creek to the south west side of said road thence along the south west side of said road to a point 65 rods east of the western line of the north west 1/4 of q. Township 15 Range 15 thence due south to the north west side of the graded dirt road thence along the north west line of said road to the south west corner of said quarter section, thence north eight rods, thence east 148 rods, thence south 41 rods, thence east 28 rods, thence northerly in a direct line to the north east corner of lot number 76, thence east to a point opposite the corner of lot No. 135, thence north to the south east of said lot including the original town plat and the additions and further hereby appoint James Taylor & M. Huston, & A. W. Colborn our agents to act in behalf of the corporate New Lexington in presenting this our petition
