

Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment. Present Thomas Sliff, Isaac York and Henson Marlow  
 Proceeded to business. Thereupon the petition of James Taylor, Mayor, A. M. Hutton, Recorder, and John W. Kelly, J. B. Gilborn, H. C. Crumley,  
 James Porter and Asa Catley, Trustees of the Incorporated Village of New Lexington, filed in the Auditor's Office on the 2<sup>d</sup> of June 1856,  
 praying that certain territory be annexed to said incorporated village, came on to be heard. The agents of the incorporated village of  
 New Lexington asked that the lines be changed from the original Petition to be as follows: Commencing at the north east corner of lot number  
 one hundred and twenty nine (29) in H. C. Crumley's addition to New Lexington, thence parallel with Main Street to the north east side  
 of Water Street, thence along the north east side of said Water Street to High Water mark on the north side of Lusk Creek, the remainder of  
 the description to remain as described in the plat and petition which alteration was accepted by the Commissioners and the said Commis-  
 sioners having fully examined the same and heard the proofs and allegations for and against said annexation and having satisfied that a  
 notice containing the substance of said petition and stating the time and place for the hearing thereof had been published in the New-  
 Lexington Locomotive, a newspaper printed and of general circulation in the County of Perry not less than six consecutive weeks before the  
 time of the hearing of said petition, and the Commissioners being further satisfied that the limits of said proposed territory to be annexed  
 and accurately described in said petition and a correct map thereof made and attached to said petition; and it moreover appearing to  
 said Com. to be right and proper that the prayer of said petitioners should be granted it is therefore ordered by the Com. that the said  
 contiguous territory described in said petition as changed by leave of the Com. be annexed to and become a part of said Incorporated  
 Village of New Lexington.
