



# ADDITION TO NEW LEXINGTON.

I do hereby certify that the annexed plat and description of Carroll's Addition to New Lexington is correct.

Carroll's Addition to New Lexington laid out April 19<sup>th</sup> 1860. James Saylor Surveyor and Jacob R. Thurston and William B. Fulton chain carriers who were sworn before entering upon their duties. Carroll's Addition to New Lexington is situated on the south east quarter of Section No. Four (4) in Township fifteen (15) of Range Fifteen (15) Commencing at the south west corner of said quarter section thence north on the quarter section line 265 feet thence east 60 feet to a stone (estimated to weigh 35 pounds) at the south west corner of lot No. 247 the beginning of the plat. The lots are all 50 feet wide and 150 feet long except lot No. 262 which is 150 feet long on the west line, and the east line is diminished in length by the angle of Mill Street as marked on the plat. North Mill Street runs due east and is 60 feet wide. RR Street is 60 feet wide from the center of the Railroad & runs in the direction of said road as marked on the plat. The alleys are all 15 feet wide and run parallel or at right angles with North Mill Street. Said streets and alleys are ceded in trust to the public for highways. Executed by Benjamin Carroll and Susan Carroll his wife this 25<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1860.
