Know all men by these Presents that I William Van Keyde, Secretary of the Strattsville Mining Company, by virtue of the powers in me vested by the laws of the State of Ohio and the resolutions of said Strattsville Mining Company. The said Strattsville Mining Company having caused the lands in the attached Plat to be surveyed, platted and laid off into Lots, Streets, and Alleys as a town, which has been named and designated as ~~the town of~~ New Strattsville, do hereby dedicate the same as a town by such name of New Strattsville. And I as such Secretary by virtue of the powers in me vested as aforesaid, do hereby dedicate the several streets and alleys as delineated on the attached plat of said town by Levi Davis Surveyor ofocking County, Ohio, to Public use as such streets and alleys as long as such ~~town~~ shall continue a town. Witness my hand and seal this 19th day of July A.D. 1870.

I hereby certify that I have surveyed, platted and laid out for the Strattsville Mining Company of the State of Ohio a town of which the attached is a correct plat to be known and designated as New Strattsville which is located in Salt Lick Township, Perry County Ohio, and comprises a part of the southwest quarter of Section No. 29, Township No. 14, Range No. 15, Beginning 13.71 chains east and south 16° 48' links from the north west corner of the south west quarter of said Section No. 29 and thence as delineated upon the foregoing plat containing 32 acres. The size of each lot is marked on the plat in links and fractions of links. The streets are located and named as delineated upon the plat and are each 91 links wide. The alleys are located as delineated on the plat and are each 25 links wide. The space between the town lots and Railroad is reserved for street and other purposes and for said Strattsville Mining Company's use. Witness my hand this 19th day of July A.D. 1870.
