



# TRIO CITY

containing fifty lots and numbered from one to fifty and are all sixty six by one hundred and thirty two feet, except lot No. one, the size and angle of which is shown on the plat. The width of the streets and alleys are shown in figures on the plat of each. The lots are situated in the northeast quarter of section number ten Township fifteen, Range number sixteen and being in Jackson Township Perry County Ohio, and on the north side and abutting on the land of the Cincinnati & Muskingum Valley Railroad Stones are planted as shown on the plat to regulate future surveys.

The above plat includes seventeen and thirty nine hundredths (17.39%) acres, bounded on the south by the lands of said Cincinnati & Muskingum Valley Railway Company on the west by the west line of said quarter section, and center thread of the Logan Road. The south west corner of the above plat is twenty two chains and sixty links north of the southwest corner of said quarter section.
