



# HUSTON'S ADDITION OF LOTS TO HIS FIRST ADDITION TO NEW LEXINGTON

Full note of a Survey made for R. E. Huston Esq. - Beginning on Jackson Street at a stake in the south East corner of Mr. Peter Huffys land, thence north 57 East 4 chains, thence east 11.03 chains, thence south 15 chains, thence West 12 chains and 11 links, thence north 39 West 3 chains and 32 links, to point of beginning. The lots are numbered from east to west on the south side of Eastern Avenue, and from west to east on the north side of Eastern Avenue. Each lot contains 1/5 rods, or one fifth of an acre, with the exception of lots number 347, 352, 358, 359, 360, 365 & 370, - the area of which are given in the plat in rods and hundredths of a rod. The linear distances on the sides of the irregular lots are given in chains and links. The Streets are each 75 links or 49 1/2 feet wide and the Alleys one rod wide.
