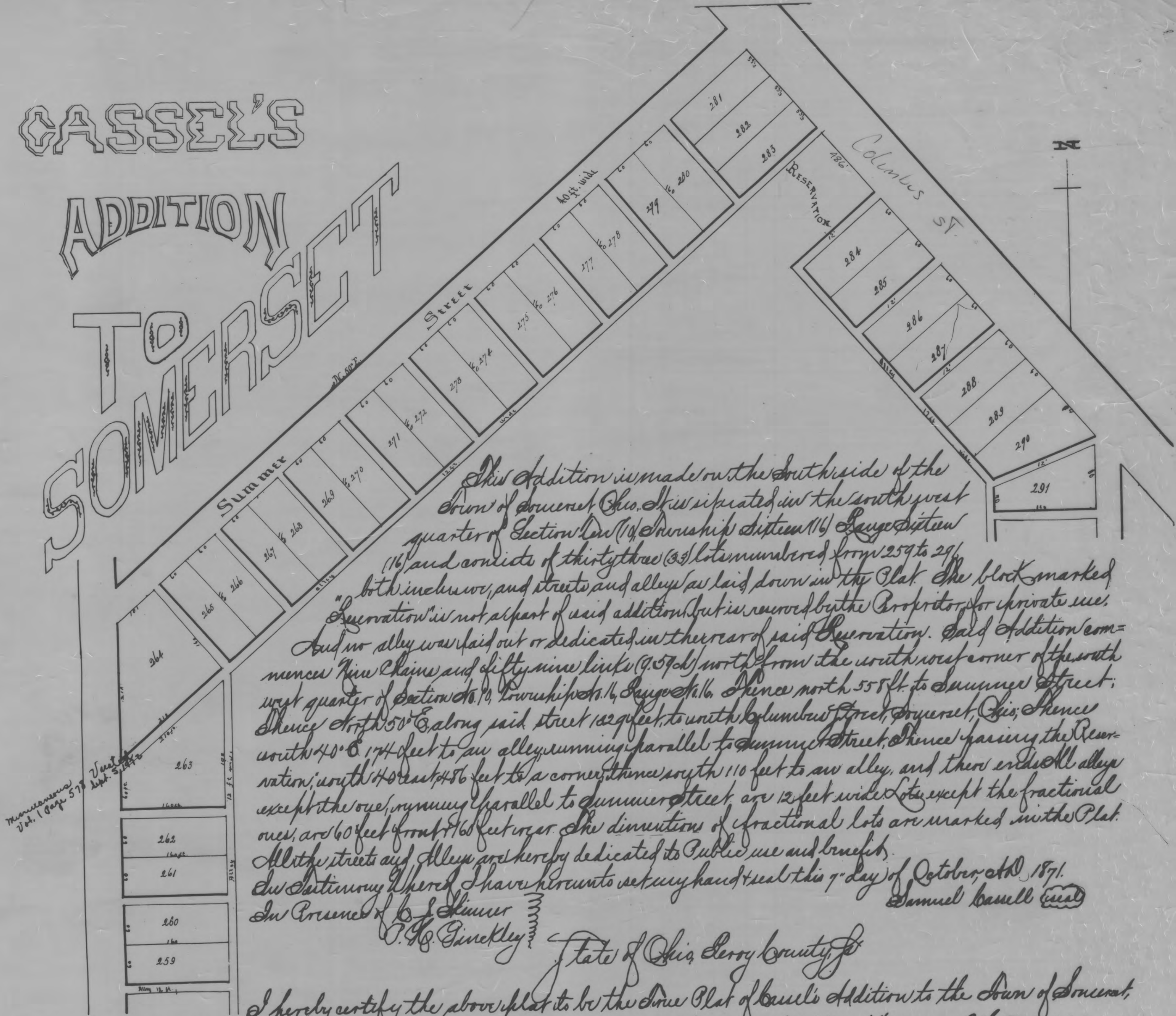


CASSEY'S

ADDITION TO SOMERSET



This Addition is made on the south side of the town of Somerset, Ohio, this is situated in the south west quarter of Section No. 10, Township No. 16, Range No. 16, and consists of thirty three (33) lots numbered from 259 to 291 both inclusive, and streets and alleys as laid down in the Plat. The block marked "Reservation" is not a part of said addition, but is reserved by the Proprietor for private use, and no alley was laid out or dedicated in the rear of said Reservation. Said Addition commences with chains and fifty nine links (957 ft) north from the south west corner of the south west quarter of Section No. 10, Township No. 16, Range No. 16. Thence north 55 ft. to Summer Street; thence north 50 ft. along said street 122 feet to north Columbus Street, Somerset, Ohio; thence north 40 ft. 174 feet to an alley running parallel to Summer Street, thence facing the Reservation; north 40 feet 456 feet to a corner, thence south 110 feet to an alley, and thence ends. All alleys except the one, running parallel to Summer Street, are 12 feet wide. Lots except the fractional ones, are 60 feet front by 60 feet or more. The dimensions of fractional lots are marked in the Plat. All the streets and alleys are hereby dedicated to Public use and benefit.
