

Ordinance No. 30.

An Ordinance to widen a Street and Alley.

Be it ordained by the Council of the T. of as follows:
 Sec. 1. That Whereas on the 21st day of April, 1890, a petition was presented to the Council to widen East Street from its present width, 28 feet, to 44 feet, also to convert the 16 foot alley north of lots 185 to 194, inclusive, and it appearing that no person other than the petitioners will be in any way interested or damaged thereby and consideration of said petitioners releasing all claims to compensation or damages for said purpose as prayed for. Be it ordained by the Council of the village of Junction City, Perry County, Ohio, that said East Street and said Alley be widened according to the prayer of said petition as therein set forth and that the prayer officers and hereby, authorized to carry same into effect and be in force from and after its earliest period allowed by law.
