

# EDMINSON'S ADDITION TO JUNCTION CITY

See OR 90 P802 for Ord 92-006 - VACATION



John Edminson's Addition to Junction City contains 194 lots (1/4), including Streets, Alleys and lots, occupies 57 1/2 acres of Ground, and is situated in the northeast quarter of section Six, Township Fifteen, Range Sixteen and in Jackson Township, Perry County, Ohio. The north west corner of lot number one, is two three chains north of the south west corner of said quarter section. Stones are planted at the north west corner of lot number 20, and the north east corner of lot number eleven, to regulate future surveys. Figures on the lines of lots, indicate the size in feet and hundredths. The width of Streets and alleys are written on each respectively. Figures placed on the lots indicate their number. Surveyed and platted, December 1871, for John Edminson the Proprietor, all of which is certified to be correct.

Be it remembered that on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1882 before me the undersigned a Justice of the Peace in and for said County personally came John Edminson and Elizabeth Edminson his wife the grantors in the foregoing instrument and acknowledged the signing and sealing thereof to be their voluntary act and deed for the uses and purposes therein mentioned and the said Elizabeth Edminson wife of the said John Edminson being examined by me separate and apart from her said husband and the contents of said instrument being by me made known and explained to her as the Statute directs she then declared that she did voluntarily sign seal and acknowledge the same and that she is still satisfied therewith as her act and deed for the uses and purposes therein mentioned. In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name on the day and year last above mentioned.

Ordinance No. 29 - Passed Aug. 9<sup>th</sup> 1890

Be it ordained by the Council of the - - - as follows: That whereas on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1890 a petition was presented to the Council for the vacation of all Streets and Alleys included within the following bounds, to wit: On the north by 16 foot alley, on the East by East Street, and the south by Front Street, and on the west by Sycamore Street, except however Main Street from Sycamore Street to East Street. Notice of the passage and prayer of which has been given as required by Law, and whereas upon hearing the Council was satisfied that there is first cause for such vacation, and that the same would not be detrimental to the general interest, and should be made, therefore be it ordained by the Council of the village of Junction City, Perry County, Ohio, that said Streets and Alleys as heretofore described and as prayed for in said petition be and the same are hereby vacated. Sec. 2 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication, Passed August the 9<sup>th</sup> 1890
