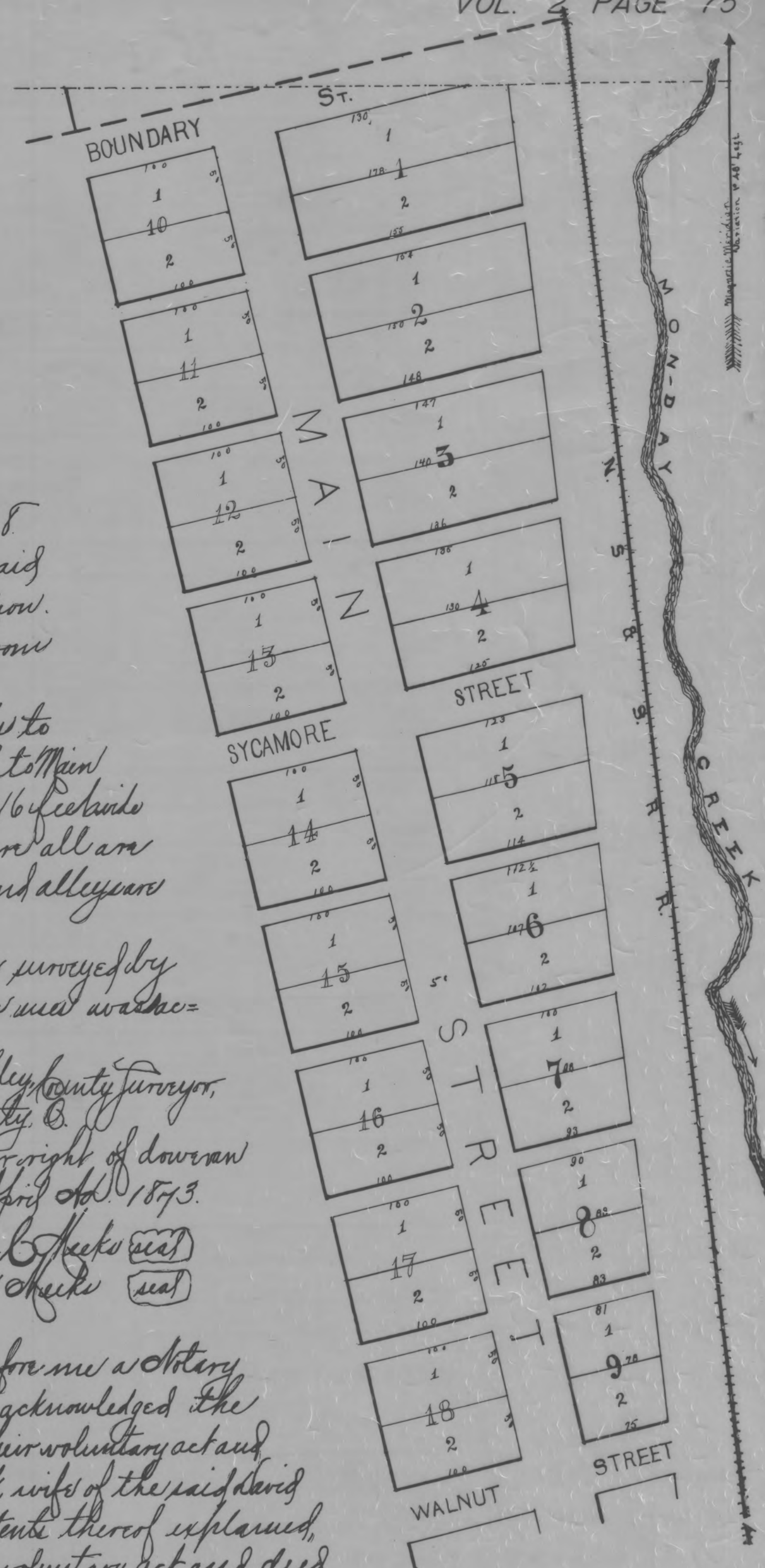


# SPRING VALLEY



### Description.

The town of Spring Valley is situated in the southwest quarter of Section No. 8 Township 14 Range 15. It commences at a governing corner in the north line of said quarter section 21.35 chains west from the northeast corner of said quarter section. The witnesses to said governing corner are two stones, one S. 60° W. distant 25 links from said corner. The other S. 60° W. distant 25 links from said corner. Main Street is 50 feet wide and bears S. 13 1/2° E. The other streets are at right angles to Main Street, and the alleys are parallel to the cross streets & rear alleys parallel to Main Street. Alleys entering from streets are 12 feet wide. Alleys in rear of lots are 6 feet wide. Lots are 50 feet front and 100 deep, except to the eastward of Main Street, where all are fractional. The dimensions of said lots are entered on the plat. The streets and alleys are dedicated to Public uses by David Meek, the proprietor of said town. I hereby certify the foregoing to be a true plat and description of said town as surveyed by me, & that the same with the dedication of said streets and alleys to Public use was acknowledged before me by said David Meek this day of April A.D. 1873.
