The annexed Plat of McCuneville located in Salt Lick Township, Perry County state of Ohio known as lying and being in Section Eight (8) Township Fourteen (14) and Range Fifteen (15) in the County of Perry and being a part of what is known as the Saltwell Farm on the line of the Newark Somerset and Stratoville Railroad and containing from fifteen to twenty acres of land. The lots are laid off in blocks numbered from 1 to 5 inclusive, and the lots in said blocks are numbered, and are of the size as marked on the plat. And the streets and alleys of the width marked on the plat, and which said streets and alleys are hereby dedicated to the public use forever for Streets and Highways
