The village of Moxahala is situated in Section 30, Township 10 North, Perry County, Ohio. A stone is placed at the intersection of the center lines of Scott, Biddison & Ewing streets, being 249 feet from the center of said section. Stones are also placed at the intersections of the center lines of Biddison & Ewing, and Ewing & Walnut Streets. The dimensions of the lots and bearing and widths of the streets are shown in the plat. I certify the above is correct.

The proprietors reserve to themselves their heirs and assigns the right to use the space lying on each side of the A. & C. Railway line and to grant the same to said A. & C. Railway Company or any other Railway Company, and also to use the space lying along the north westerly side of the plat from lot No. 1 to 57 inclusive, except 15 feet immediately in the rear of the lots fronting southeasterly on Biddison Street. They reserve the right to grant the same to any Railway Company at their discretion.
