

The streets are each fifty feet wide, and the alleys each 16 feet wide. The dimensions of the lots are indicated on the map in feet and tenths of feet. The angle at the changes of direction in the streets and the angle of intersection of streets and the several points at which stones are planted for future reference are indicated on the plat.

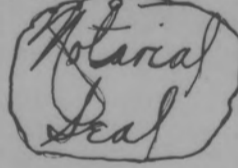
