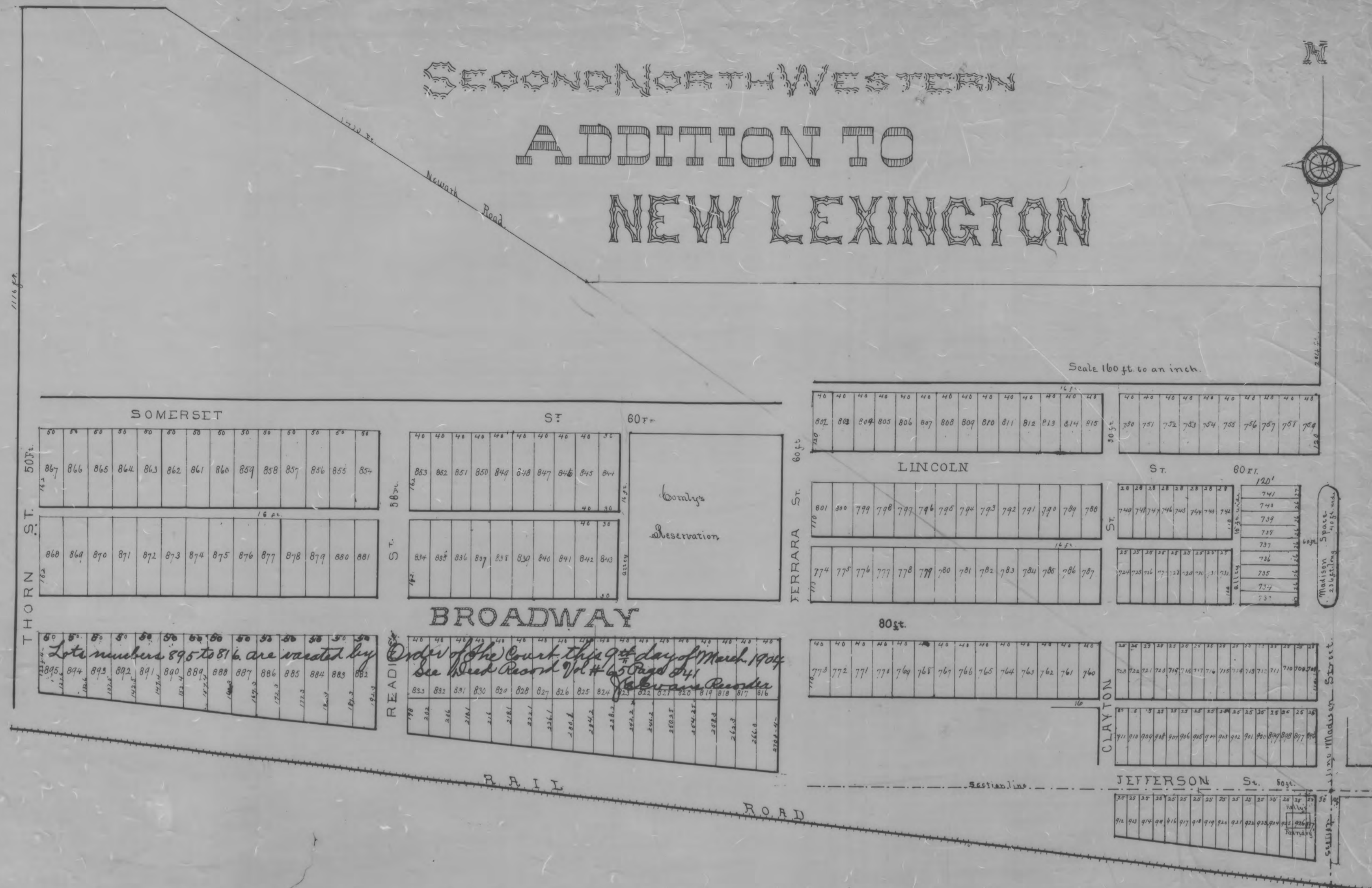


SECOND NORTHWESTERN

ADDITION TO NEW LEXINGTON



Order of the Court, this 9th day of March, 1904. See Record Vol. 45 Page 841. Value and Recorder.

This plat of lots is situated in and being part of the south east quarter of Section No. 5, and a part of the north east quarter of Section No. 8, and a part of the north west quarter of section No. 9, Township Fifteen (15) Range Fifteen Perry County Ohio. The lots are numbered from 718 to 927 inclusive. The numbers and divisions of the lots are marked on them. The numbers in figures, and the dimensions in feet and tenths of a foot. The widths of the streets and alleys are marked on them in feet. The streets and alleys run east and west north and south crossing each other at right angles. The names of the streets are written upon them. Madison Square is 1/2 foot wide, and 236 ft. long, and is dedicated to the public use for the erection of monuments, fountains &c. All of which is truly and correctly reported on the adjoining plat surveyed and plotted for the Proprietors, and I hereby certify that the same is correct. Mark Ludon, Surveyor.
