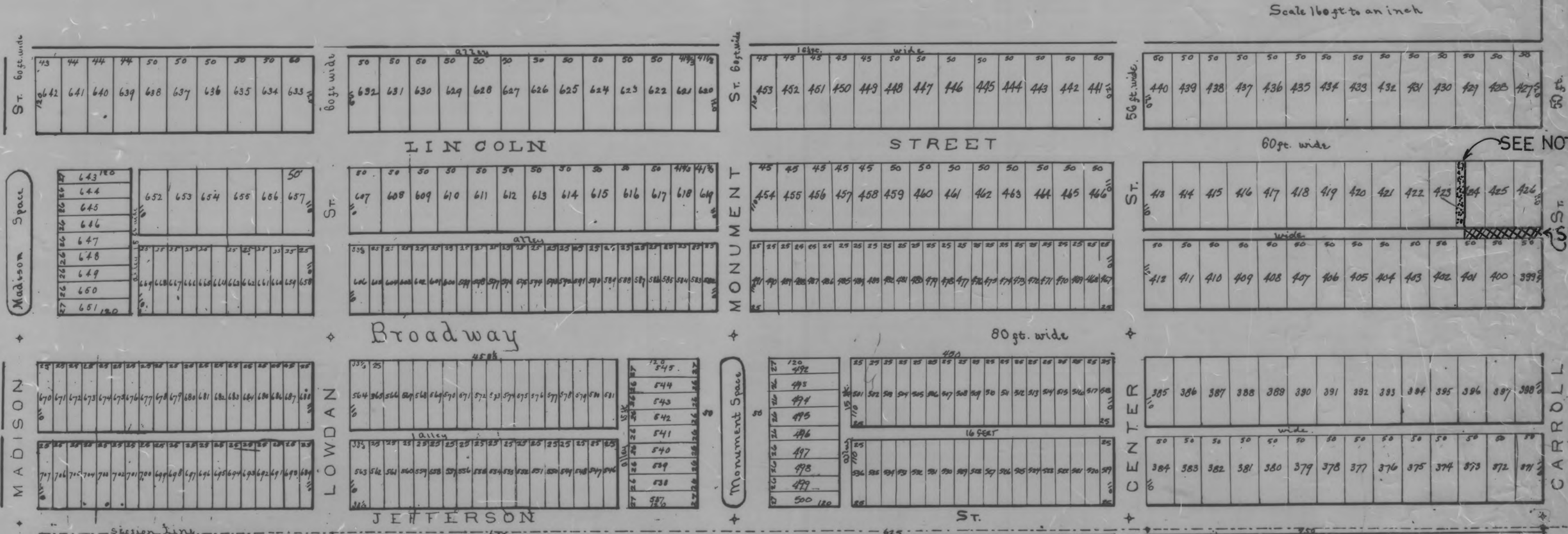


# NORTH ADDITION TO NEW LEXINGTON



This Plat is situated on the south side of the south west quarter of Section four (4) in Township Fifteen (15) of Range Fifteen (15) and extends from the eastern to the western boundaries of said quarter section. The figures on the lines indicate the length and width of the lots in feet. Streets are platted at the points marked p - the same being at the center of the Street Crossings. Jefferson Street, Broadway and Lincoln St. run east and west, Carroll, East Monument and Madison Streets run north and south. The Alley runs parallel with the streets. The width of the streets and alleys is indicated in figures on each Monument Space and Madison Space are each forty (40) feet wide, and 20 feet long. Both spaces are dedicated perpetually to the public for the erection of monuments, fountains &c.
