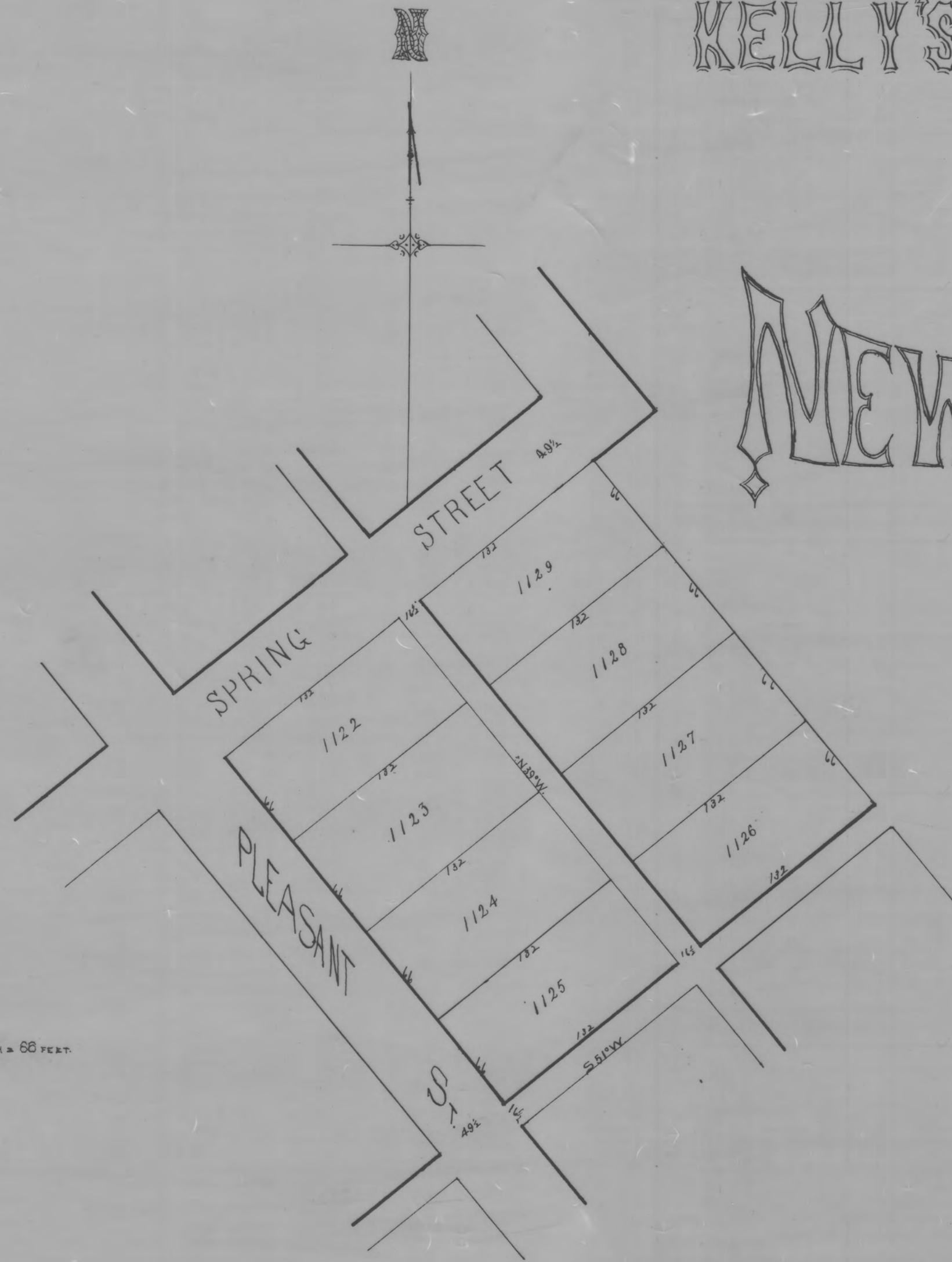



NEW LEXINGTON

This plat of Lots is situated in the N.W. 1/4 of Section 9, Tp. 15, R. 15, Pike Sp. Perry County Ohio, and lies immediately south and east of the intersection of Spring and Pleasant streets, as located in John H. Kelly's 1st Addition to the Town of New Lexington. The lines of the lots run parallel to said streets, and are 66 feet by 732 feet. Lots numbered from 1122 to 1129 inclusive. They are separated as shown on the plat by an alley one rod wide, the course of which is S. 39° W. of New. C. Strong Surveyor.


