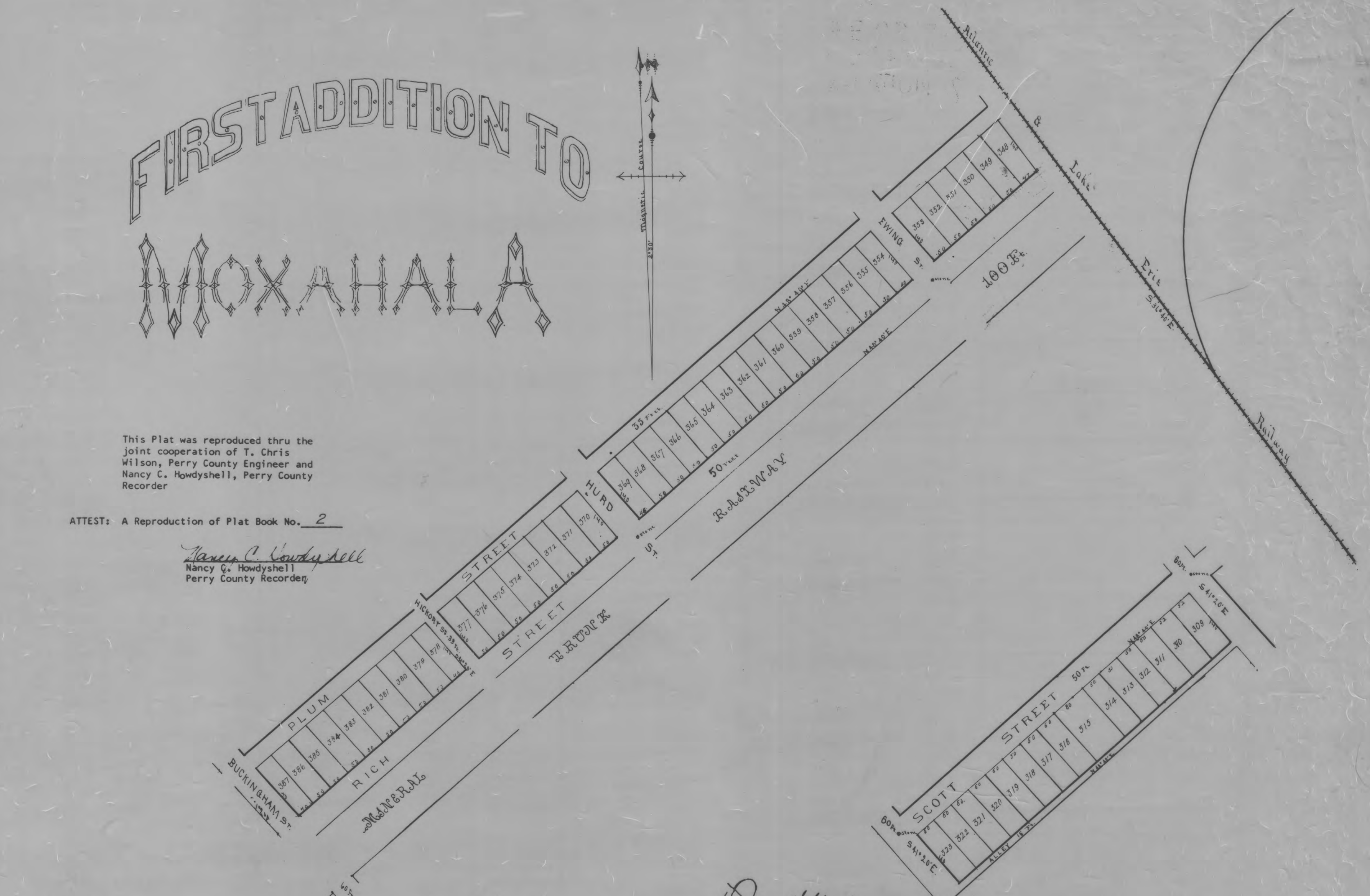


FIRST ADDITION TO MOXAHALA

Description

The first addition to the Village of Moxahala is situated in Section 30, Pleasant Township, Perry County, Ohio. Biddison Street of this addition is a continuation of Biddison Street in the Original Plat. The number of lots from 324 to 347 inclusive front on said street. A stone is planted at the intersection of the center lines of Ewing & Rich Streets being 41' 20" N 64° 22' E and 27' 22" feet from a stone planted at the intersection of the center lines of Biddison and Ewing Streets of the Original Plat. Rich Street is parallel to Biddison Street. Lots fronting on Rich Street number from 348 to 377 inclusive. A stone is planted at the intersection of the center lines of Ewing & Scott Streets being 54' 20" E 75° 54' 2" feet from a stone planted at the intersection of the center lines of Biddison & Ewing Streets of the original plat. Scott Street is parallel to Biddison Street. Lots fronting on Scott Street number from 387 to 323 inclusive. Stones are also planted at the intersection of the center lines of Hurd & Scott, Hurd & Rich and Biddison & Buckingham Streets. The dimensions of the lots, and bearings and widths of the streets & alleys are given in the Plat.

Know all men by these Presents, that James Taylor, Amanda N. Taylor, ^{his wife} A. S. Biddison & Laura A. Biddison his wife, Proprietors of the foregoing Addition to the Town of Moxahala, Perry County, Ohio, do hereby dedicate the streets and Alleys as laid out on the accompanying Plat to Public use. Reserving to ourselves the use of 20 feet taken evenly off of the southeast side of Rich St. its entire length for Railroad purposes for the "Municipal Bond" or other railroad Company which may be designated by us.
