Description.

The second addition to the Village of Moxamala is situated in section 30, Pleasant Township, Perry Co. Ohio. South Fowler Street of this addition are a continuation of South Fowler Street in the original plat. A stone is planted at the intersection of the center line of Fowler Street being 41.50 E. and 66 feet from the center of said section. And 365 feet from a stone planted at the intersection of the center line of Bidduon, Fowler and Huston Streets. Stones are also planted at the intersection of the center line of Johnson & Fowler & Scott & Clayton Streets. Lots in this addition, number from 227 to 301 inclusive, also lots 388 & 389. The dimensions of the lots and bearings, and width of the streets and alleys are shown in the plat.
