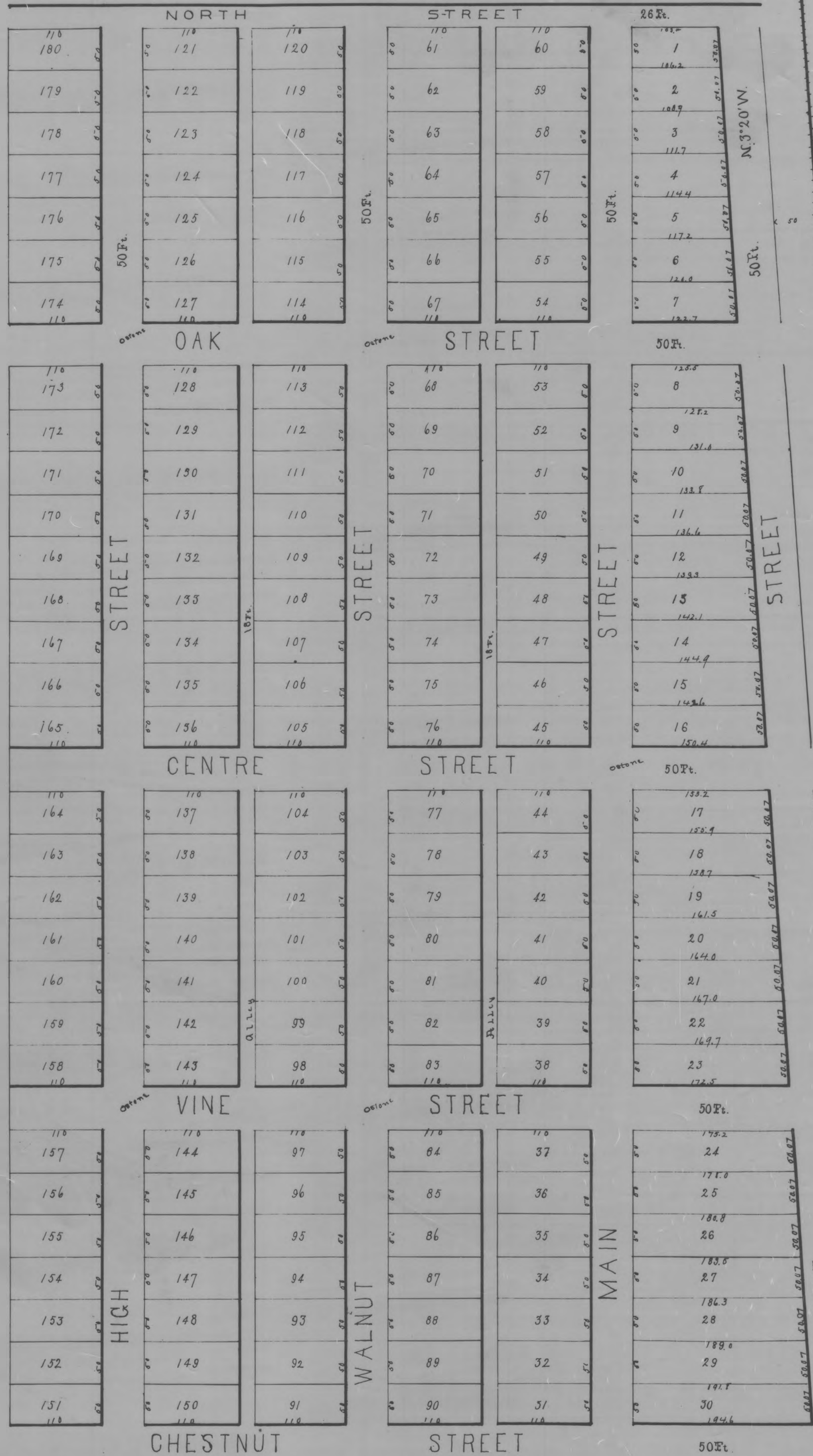

Description!
The Village of Dickson is situated in the east half of the south west quarter of section number 3, Township fifteen (Pike) Perry County Ohio. It is situated at the intersection of the center lines of High & Oak Streets, being each 130 feet, thence south 40 feet from a stone planted at the north west corner of the east half of said quarter section. The bearings of the streets and alleys are north and south and east and west, excepting Oak Street which is north 8° 20' West (magnetic Variation 1° 30' West) stones are also planted at the intersection of the center lines of High & Vine, Walnut & Vine, Walnut & Oak, Main & Centre, Main & Chestnut streets. The dimensions of the lots and widths of the streets and alleys are shown in feet on the Plat and certify the above to be correct.

Dedication of Plat
