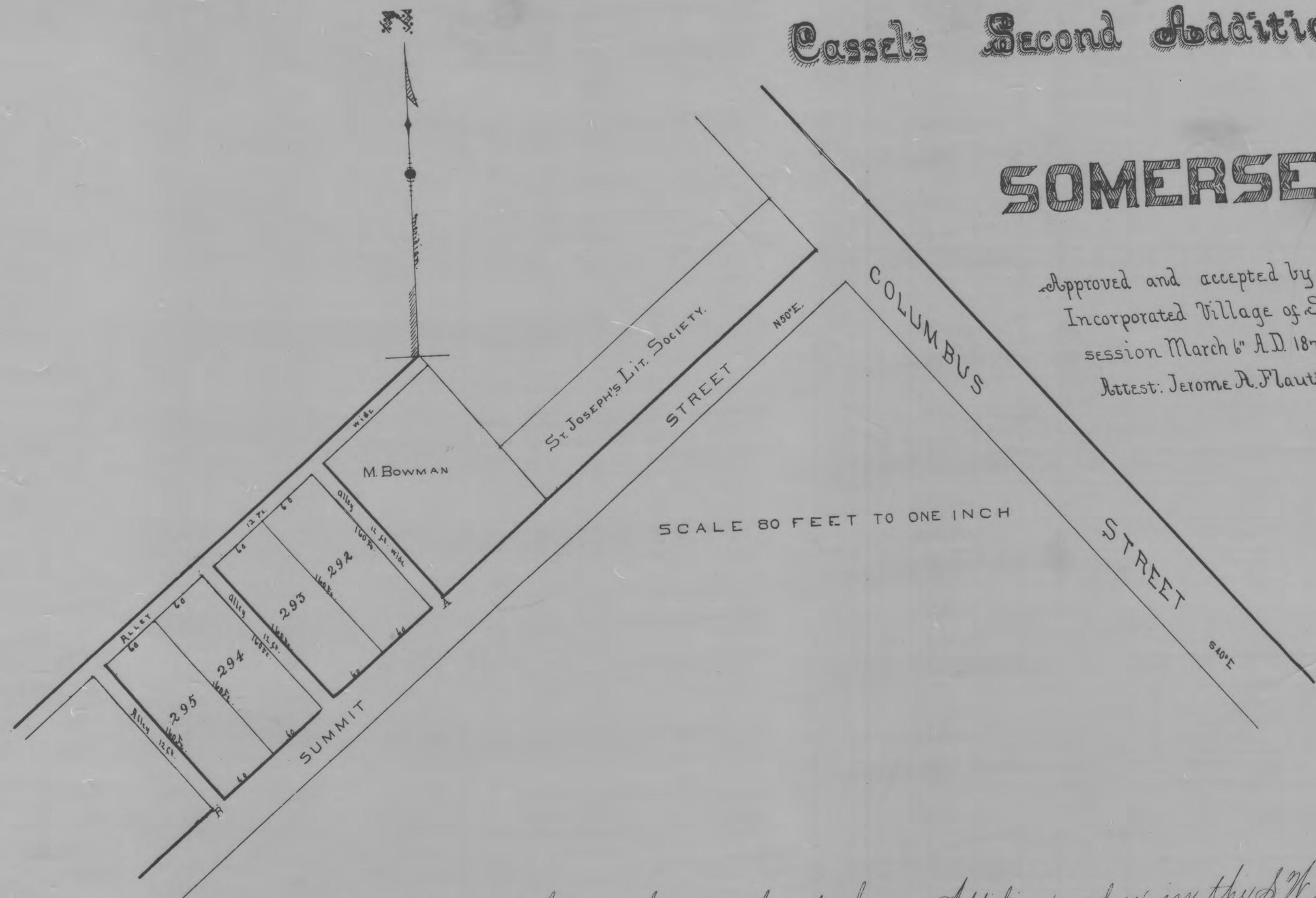


Cassels Second Addition to

SOMERSET



Approved and accepted by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Somerset Ohio in session March 6th A.D. 1876.

This Addition is located on the north side of Summit Street in Cassels former Addition, and is in the S.W. quarter of Section No 16, Township No. 16, Range No. 16. It consists of four lots, laid off in two blocks with an alley on all sides of each block. Except the front lots, including one half the alleys, containing 1/4 of an acre of land each. This Addition commences at the South western corner of Michael Bowman's lot at A in the foregoing Plat. The point of commencement is 429 3/4 feet S 50° W from the S.E. corner of the lot belonging to St. Joseph's Literary Society which corner is in the center of the street 33 feet S 50° E from the fence post at the S.E. corner of the inclosure of the bearing of Summit Street is S 50° W or S 50° E. And the alley in the rear of the lots of this addition is parallel to said Street. The other alleys are at right angles bearing N 40° W from the line of the street. This addition ends on the west side of the Alley, at the S.E. corner of the tract of land lying westward of said Alley and cornering on said street B. The alley to the rear of the lots, extend eastward to the line of the lot belonging to St. Joseph's Literary Society before referred to. The most south westerly corner of this Addition is marked B on the Plat. I hereby certify the foregoing Plat and Description to be correct and true.

Cassel, wife of said Samuel Cassel, being unmarried, gave, separate and apart from her said husband and the contents of said Plat + Description, and the purpose thereof having been made known by to her, did on such separate Examination, acknowledge that she did voluntarily sign and seal the same and that she is still satisfied therewith.
