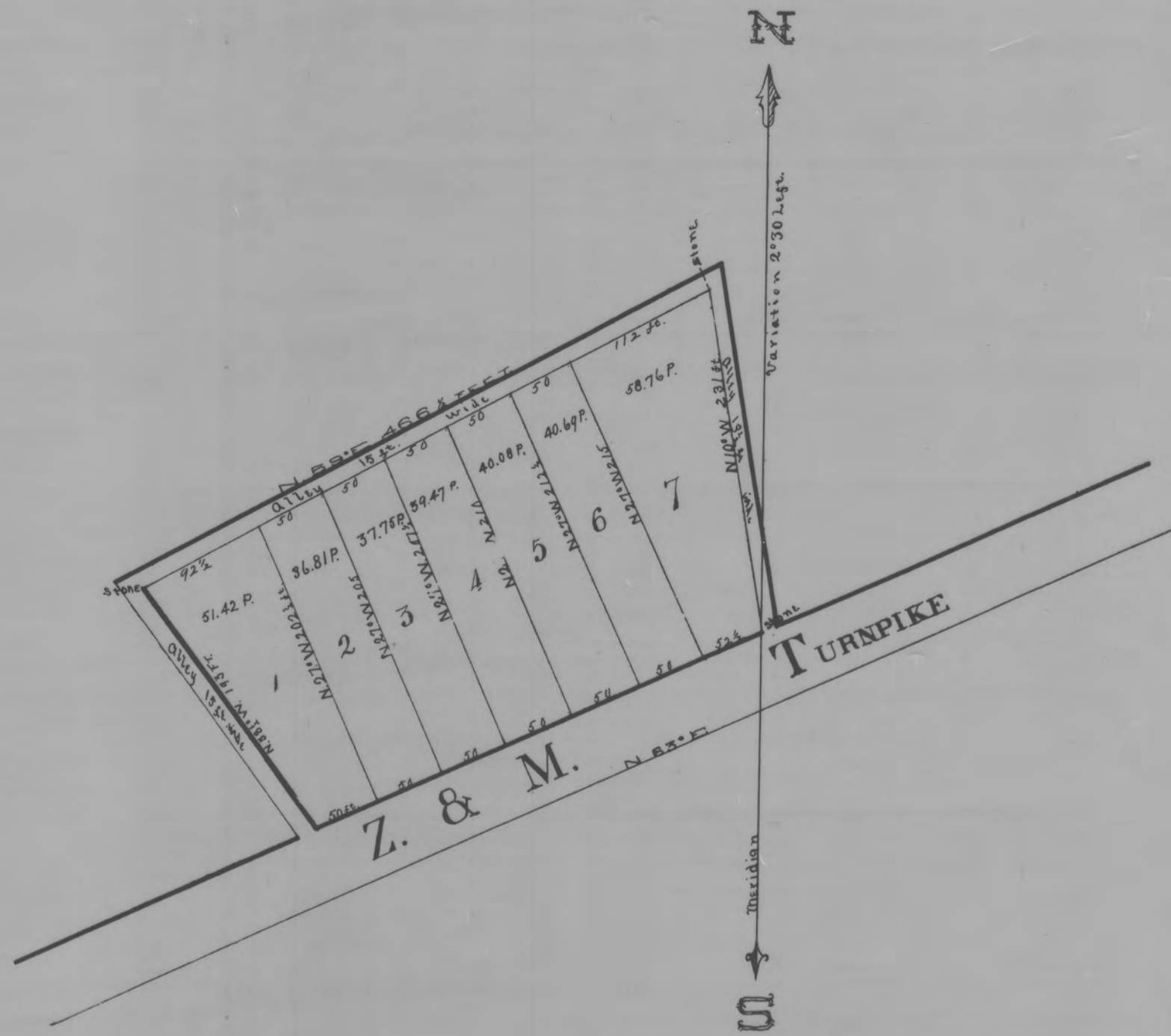


JOHNSON'S ADDITION TO SOMERSET

Description

Said Addition is situated in the northwest quarter of Section No. 10 Township No. 16, Range No. 16, Perry Co. Ohio, and consists of Block 1, alley described as follows, viz: Commencing at a corner stone at the entrance of Kinard Phillips Lane, leading in from the Pike, thence @ 63° 04' 35 1/2" feet, thence @ 87° 12' 10" feet to a stone at the north side of the Alley, in the hedge, thence @ 90° 0' 0" feet to a corner stone in the lane aforesaid, thence @ 90° 0' 0" feet to the place of beginning. This Block is divided into 7 lots numbered from 1 to 7. The dimensions & content of land of each & the bearings of the lines thereof are all correctly entered on the above plat. At the S. E. & W. corners of the Block corner stones are set, & are all here taken as governing corners. All the lots have a front of 50 feet, excepting lot No. 7, which is 52 1/2 feet front. On the rear of Block is an Alley 15 feet wide, running @ 59° E. & opening into Phillips Lane aforesaid. Said alley is hereby dedicated to public uses forever, as a road, or way. Thereby certify the foregoing to be a true & correct description and Plat of Johnson's Addition to the Town of Somerset Perry County Ohio, as surveyed by me. Witness my hand & seal this 23rd October A.D. 1876.
