

The Incorporation of Thornville

Thornville, Ohio, Dec. 29th 1876.

The Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Thornville, for special purposes, met at their appointment, the full board being present. A petition was presented signed by the number of electors, required by law, a majority of whom were freeholders, praying that an election be held by said incorporated Village for special purposes, to obtain the sense of the electors thereof, whether or not said Village, Incorporated for Special Purposes, shall be advanced to the grade of an Incorporated Village by the name and title of the Incorporated Village of Thornville.

Whereupon, on motion of W. C. Kochensperger, it was ordered that an Election be held, on the 20th day of January 1877 at the usual place of holding elections. Also that said Election be notified of the same, as required by law.

Legal notice having been given, according to law to the electors of said Incorporated Village for special purposes that an Election would be held on the 20th day of January, 1877 for the purpose of ascertaining whether or not a majority of said electors were in favor of advancing the Incorporated Village for special purposes to the grade of an Incorporated Village - In accordance with said notice an election was held on the 20th day of January 1877. The number of votes cast at said Election "For Incorporated Village" was thirty seven (37) the number of votes cast against Incorporated Village was twenty four (24) and the whole number of votes cast at said Election was sixty one (61). The whole number of inhabitants of said Incorporation, as ascertained by a census to be taken the 22nd day of January 1877 was two hundred and eighty four (284).

I hereby certify that the foregoing is a true copy of all Journal Entries relating to proceedings had in reference to advancing the said incorporated Village for special purposes to the grade of an Incorporated Village.
