

Transcript

of proceedings in the matter of annexing certain contiguous territory to the Village of New Lexington, Ohio

At a meeting of the Council of the Incorporated Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio, held June 10<sup>th</sup>, 1896, the following ordinance was passed:

An Ordinance of Corporation Authorizing Annexation of Contiguous Territory

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Lexington as follows:

Section 1. That the annexation to the Village of New Lexington of the territory hereinafter described, be and the same is hereby authorized, viz.:

Jane Butler's First Addition, Jane Butler's Second Addition, and Carrolls Addition, said Jane Butler's First and Second Additions being situate on the North East Quarter Section Nine (9) and said Carrolls Addition being situate in the South East Quarter of Section Four (4), which is included together with other land in the following description, to wit: Commencing at the southwest corner of the south east quarter of section nine (9), Township Fifteen (15) Range Fifteen (15), Perry County, Ohio; thence east on the half section line of said section 15 perches and 8 links to a stone; thence north 120 perches and 20 links to a stone; thence west 15 perches and 8 links to a stone; thence north 40 perches to a stone on the section line between said section nine (9) and section four (4); thence west on said section line 15 perches 3 feet and 6 inches; thence due north 33 perches; thence west parallel with the south section line of said section four (4) 64 perches and 13 feet to the east Corporation line; thence south on said Corporation line 33 perches to the south section line of said section four (4); thence south 35 1/4 degrees east 396 feet to a stake on the east line of Carroll street, and being 50 feet east of the half section corner on the north boundary of said section nine (9); thence south 2 1/4 degrees east 188 feet to a stake; thence south 4 3/4 degrees east 429 feet to an oak stump; thence south 24 3/4 degrees east 1388 feet to the north east corner of lot number 364 in R. E. Huston's addition to his first addition to said Village; thence east 435 feet to the north east corner of said addition; thence south 525 feet and six (6) inches to the place of beginning.

Section 2 That the solicitor is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect such annexation

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Petition filed with County Commissioners, Sept. 8, 1896. - Charles C. Guy, Auditor.

To the Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio, Petition.

The Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio, hereby petitions your Honorable Body for the annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the said Village, and respectfully represents that by an ordinance duly passed by the Council of said Village on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1896, the territory described as follows was authorized to be annexed thereto, to-wit: Jane Butler's first addition, Jane Butler's second addition and Carrolls addition and said Jane Butler's first and second additions being situate in the North east quarter of section No. 9 and said Carrolls addition being situate in the South east quarter of section No. 4, and described as follows, to-wit: -

Commencing at the South West corner of the South east quarter of the North east quarter of section No. Nine, Township No. fifteen, and Range No. fifteen Perry County, Ohio; thence east on a half section line of said section 15 perches and 8 links to a stone; thence north 120 perches and 20 links to a stone; thence west 15 perches and 8 links to a stone; thence north 40 perches to a stone on the section line between said section nine and section four; thence west on said section line 15 perches and 3 feet and 6 inches; thence due north 33 perches; thence west parallel with South section line of said section four 64 perches and 13 feet to the East Corporation line; thence south on said Corporation line 33 perches to the South section line of said section four; thence south 35 1/4 degrees East 396 feet to a stake on the East line of Carroll street; and being 50 feet east of the half section corner on the North boundary of said section nine; thence south 2 1/4 degrees East 188 feet to a stake; thence south 4 3/4 degrees East 429 feet to an oak stump; thence south 24 3/4 degrees East 1388 feet to the North east corner of lot No. 364 in R. E. Huston's addition to his first addition to said Village; thence East 435 feet to the North east corner of said addition; thence South 525 feet and 6 inches to the place of beginning.

This day came J. E. Powell, the duly elected Village Solicitor for the Incorporated Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio and presented the following petition with accompanying plat to the Hon. Board of County Commissioners of Perry County, Ohio

Petition: - The Village of New Lexington Perry County, Ohio hereby petitions your honorable body for the annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the said Village and respectfully represents; that by an ordinance duly passed by the Council of said Village on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1896 the territory described as follows was authorized to be annexed thereto; - namely: Jane Butler's first addition, Jane Butler's second addition and Carrolls addition and said Jane Butler's first and second additions being situated in the Northeast quarter of Section No. Nine (9) and said Carrolls addition being situated in the Southeast quarter of Section No. Four (4) described as follows, to-wit: -

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of section No. Nine (9) Township No. Fifteen (15) and Range No. Fifteen (15) Perry County, Ohio; thence east on a half section line of said section 15 perches and 8 links to a stone; thence north 120 perches and 20 links to a stone; thence west 15 perches and 8 links to a stone; thence north 40 perches to a stone on the section line between said section nine and section four (4); thence west on said section line 15 perches 3 feet and 6 inches; thence due north 33 perches; thence west parallel with south section line of said section four (4); thence south on said Corporation line 33 perches to the south section line of said section four (4); thence south 35 1/4 degrees East 396 feet to a stake on the east line of Carroll street, and being 50 feet east of the half section corner on the North boundary of said section nine; thence south 2 1/4 degrees East 188 feet to a stake; thence south 4 3/4 degrees East 429 feet to an oak stump; thence south 24 3/4 degrees East 1388 feet to the North east corner of lot No. 364 in R. E. Huston's addition to his first addition to said Village; thence East 435 feet to the Northeast corner of said addition; thence South 525 feet and 6 inches to the place of beginning.
