Jefferson Shellys addition to the Village of Glenford Perry County Ohio is situated in the South East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sect. 8 Township 17 R. 16 and commencing at the South East corner of said  $\frac{1}{4}$  section thence West 392 feet to the place of Beginning thence West 738 feet thence North 298 feet thence West 282 feet thence S.  $14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West 84 ft. thence N.  $27^{\circ}$  W 239 ft thence East 184  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. thence N.  $14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 344 ft. thence S.  $75^{\circ}$  East 146 ft. thence S.  $104\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. 24. 306 thence East 100 ft thence South 182 feet thence East 724 ft thence South 146 ft to the place of beginning containing  $1\frac{1}{2}$  acres

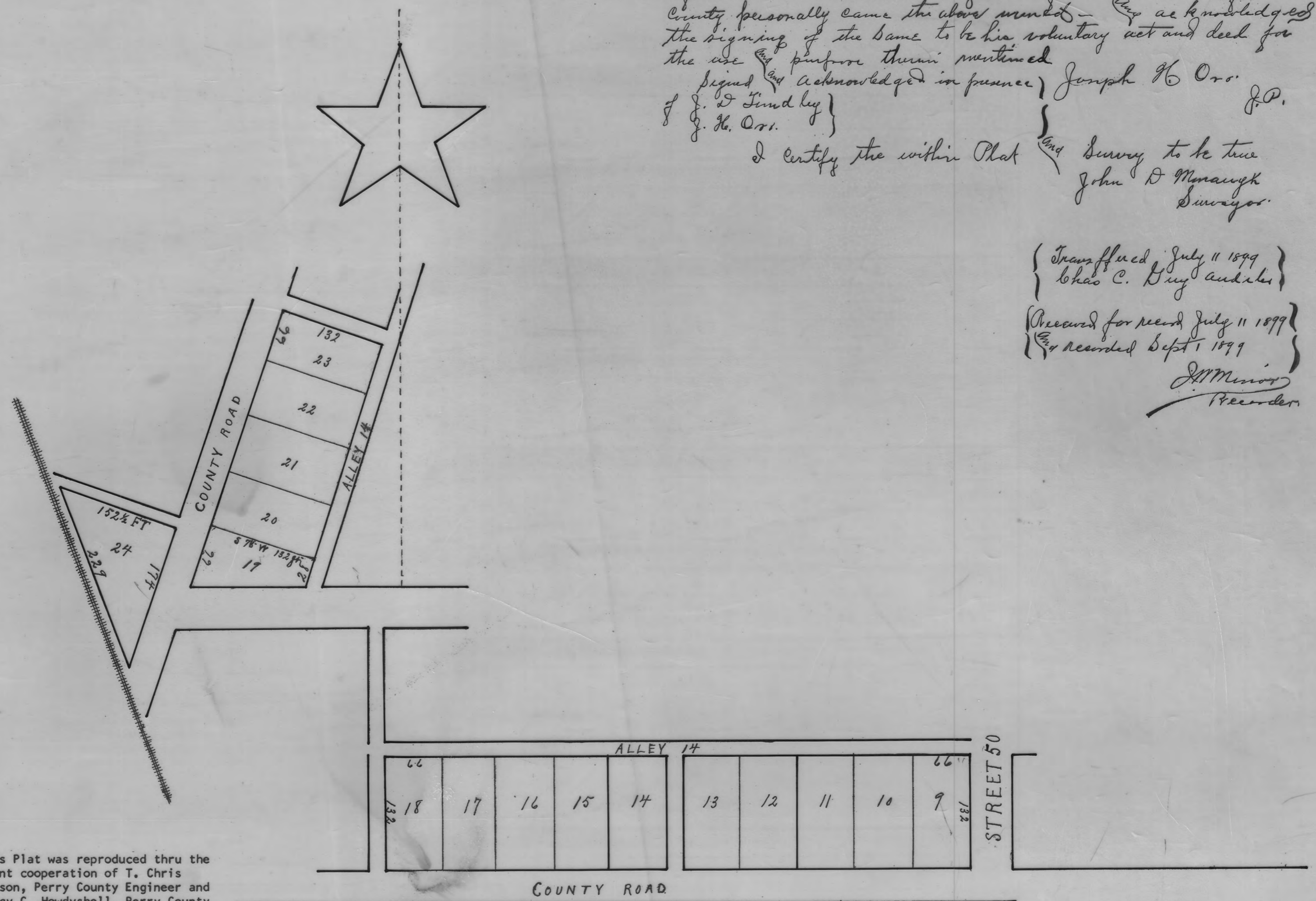
